



LOCAL RESIDENT PUBLISHES NOVEL



Congratulations to Ivor Foster on the recent publication of a novel he wrote called "Not Just a Man's World Anymore". Ivor is a local resident who has served on town council and has been involved in many community activities. He has always had an interest in creative writing and in aviation, especially the sport of 'gliding' and combined these two interests into a novel about a young girl learning to fly.

"In Ivor Foster's novel we meet Kelti Ferguson, seventeen years old and a high school student in Edmonton. We also meet her coterie of friends and acquaintances, among whom are Sarah Oatman, the garrulous Marnie Foster and Li Nguyen from a Vietnamese family recently arrived from Los Angeles. Early on we also meet her boyfriend, Jeff Lampley who is quarterback on the school football team. When he and Kelti break up she tells him that he should "find someone with the brains of a gnat to stroke that overstuffed football ego of yours". Kelti is obviously no one to trifle with. I read with great interest your publication of an old copy of the paper THE VILLAGE VOICE. It brought back memories for me. I have some background information on this paper.

I noticed this example was VOL. 1 #1 so it was the first copy issued. The paper was based in Warburg and was started by Jim Deagan who lived in Warburg at that time.

I believe he was originally from Ontario but in 1980 he drove a cement mixer truck for Apollo Ready Mix which was based in Warburg. Apollo had started in 1979 and in those days it shut down for the winter months. I also started at Apollo in 1980. I remember Jim talking about starting a newspaper for the local area when Apollo would shut down for the season.

This he did. I don't know if he printed and published it himself or if he had that done by someone else. Likewise I don't know if he gathered the news stories himself or if someone else reported them. There wasn't internet or emails those days so if he gathered them himself, he was a busy man.

Judging by the quality of the stories and layout of the paper, Jim must have had previous newspaper experience.

Jim didn't return to Apollo in spring of '81 and moved away after presumably finding employment elsewhere thus ending what could be called a forerunner of the Breton Booster.





STABILIZING ALBERTA'S PRIMARY HEALTH CARE SYSTEM

Alberta News, April 4, 2024

Alberta's government is delivering on a commitment to provide funding to help family doctors with their administrative costs so they can devote more time to seeing patients.

Primary care is the foundation of Alberta's health care system, and family physicians are fundamental to Albertans getting the care they need when and where they need it. That's why Alberta's government is pulling out all the stops to stabilize, strengthen and improve Alberta's primary health care system.

The additional one-time funding has been provided to the Alberta Medical Association (AMA) as part of a December 2023 commitment of \$200 million over two years to stabilize primary health care. The AMA will distribute the funding to eligible family physicians and rural generalists.

"We heard what primary care physicians told us about the challenges they are facing, and we've taken action to address those challenges. Alberta's government is pleased to provide this one-time funding to support family physicians and rural generalists until a new physician comprehensive care model is introduced." Adriana LaGrange, Minister of Health

Approximately 3,000 family doctors are eligible to receive transition funding of \$24,000 to \$40,000. The amount a family physician and rural generalist will receive depends on the number of patients they have.

The funding is a one-time payment aimed at helping family doctors and rural generalists until a new compensation model is in place. It will be used for administrative and equipment costs related to the number of patients they manage.

"We are grateful that this funding will help family and rural generalist physicians remain in comprehensive, life-long care as we move to the next phase of collaboration with the minister and her team. For this stabilization investment to reap benefits for Albertans, we must rapidly implement the new payment model that will allow comprehensive care to flourish across the province." Dr. Paul Parks, president, Alberta Medical Association

This funding is enabled through the new Canada-Alberta Health Funding Agreement with the federal government. The agreement represents a total of about \$1.1 billion in additional health care funding over three years for shared priorities.

Quick facts

 Stabilization funding is a transitional measure identified through work under the memorandum of understanding (MOU) between the minister of health

- and the Alberta Medical Association that was signed in fall 2023.
- In December, \$200 million over two years was announced to help stabilize primary care. This includes the \$92 million announced April 4 and \$8 million for the residency incentive program.
- Other recently announced supports for primary health care include:
- Providing ongoing base compensation for primary care physicians that is expected to be more than \$2.3 billion in 2024-25.
- Committing to create a primary-care organization within the refocused provincial health care system to co-ordinate primary health care services and provide transparent provincial oversight, with the goal of ensuring every Albertan will have a family physician or primary care provider.
- Investing \$40 million over two years to support Primary Care Networks.
- Investing \$12 million for the Community Information Integration and Central Patient Attachment Registry, enabling doctors and their teams to share patient information from their electronic medical record to Alberta Netcare.
- Committing to implement recommendations from the Modernizing Alberta's Primary Health Care System initiative through a phased approach.
- Creating a primary health care division within Alberta Health.

2024 Dust Control Program

Application deadline: Wednesday, May 15

Leduc County is currently accepting applications for our 2024 dust control program. There are two product choices available:

1. Calcium chloride

Calcium chloride is a top shoot dust control product that is applied by spraying over the gravel surface.

- Two applications of product will be completed for every residence applying for this dust control product. The second application will be automatically applied approximately six-to-eight weeks after the first application (weather permitting).
- Residents desiring a calcium chloride dust control product on the County road adjacent to their residence will be required to complete an application form and must prepay a fee of **\$573.75** for the first 122 metres (400 feet). Dust control requested beyond 122 metres (400 feet) will be charged an additional \$9.41/metre.

2. Incorporated petroleum

Incorporated dust control is a petroleum-based product that is applied to the road surface and mixed in and packed by

- · It is warrantied for one year from the date of application.
- · Residents desiring an incorporated dust control product on the County road adjacent to their residence will be required to complete an application form and must prepay a fee of \$4,426.25 for the first 122 metres (400 feet). Dust control beyond 122 metres (400 feet) will be charged an additional \$40.98/metre.

Other information

- GST will be added to all prices listed above.
- The prices listed are after receiving a Leduc County subsidy of \$573.75 per strip.
- This subsidy is provided to County residents living in permanent residences along a county gravel road.
- Businesses will be charged the full rate without subsidv.
- · The dust control program begins as soon as possible after seasonal road bans have been lifted.
