Many groups rely on membership dues as their primary source of revenue but must fundraise for additional funds for a project or program. Volunteer groups are in no way affiliated with our local municipal government projects that are paid with our taxes like roads, sidewalks and regular maintenance. Groups can apply for funding from the government but any funds donated to organizations are already allocated to community projects or events through the budget process.

When registering to be a non profit group or organization, goals and objectives must be clearly outlined. Each group has a different purpose to serve our community. Here are a few examples of volunteer organizations and their goals.

<u>Chamber of Commerce Groups</u> - By connecting businesses, supporting entrepreneurs, advocating for business interests, promoting tourism and events, and fostering workforce development, they contribute to the growth and prosperity of local economies.

<u>Community Hall Organizations</u> - Volunteers manage, maintain and rent out their facility. They also organize events and rely on grants, donations and fundraising. Any money raised goes directly to their projects and facilities.

<u>Seniors organizations</u> - their goals are to reduce social isolation, promote social connection and improve the well-being of seniors. Volunteer seniors host events, fundraise, apply for grants and in many cases build and/or maintain a building.

<u>School & Sports Groups</u> - their goals are to provide programs for our children. Volunteers help in the school, coach sports, organize fundraisers, build playgrounds, provide hot lunch programs and more.

Our community would look very different without volunteers - Our volunteers organize local events ... our recreation and seniors facilities were built by volunteers ... hospitals and foundations rely on volunteers ... there is no end to their value!



# Village of Warburg Council Notes

From the Regular Meeing on Jan 12, 1981

Mr. Stewart Duncan, Ed- this point, on condition that a monton Regional Plannng Commisson, attended Council to discuss the Recreation land requirement of the village.

The plan presented by Mr. Duncan subdividing the land required into two parcels one to be park reserved consisting of 5.5 acres, and the other to be purchased from Alberta Housing Corporation containing the required number of acres needed to facilitate three or four ball diamonds, was accepted.

Correspondence was read that it was Councils desire to receive extra school reserve future proposed developments in lieu of acquiring the reserve on the land being purchased for recreation purposes on the S.E. 35-48-3-W5th M.

Messrs. Merner Jappsen & Terry Stewart attended the meeting to discuss the Development Agreement with the Village, for the first phase of subdivision of a portion of the N.E. 35-48-3-W5th.

The Village Attorney, Mr. Olthius, was instructed to draw up the above Agreement,

Mr. Rick Brock, president of Matthews Group Ltd. attended the meeting to discuss Completion Certificates on the Golden Arrow Subdivision.

Council agreed that they could see no reason for delaying Completion Certificate at

5 yr. maintanence period on sidewalks be included. Mr. Brock will contact Village engineer Tony Fettig in this regard.

A Caveat will be put on each vacant lot in the Golden Arrow Development to ensure that each purchaser will be responsible for putting in his own culvert and approach to specifications of the Village.

Mr. Wells, Alberta Transportation was present to advise Council of road requirements re: the annexation application of Madison Developments.

On April 10, 2024, grade 7-12 student leaders from schools across the Black Gold School Division, along with their teacher leaders, gathered at the Division Office in Nisku to take part in leadership training and discussions.

"The day-long event provided many opportunities for the students to share their thoughts with each other and the Board of Trustees about their successes and challenges, and on how to make our schools even better," said Division Principal Raymond Cable.

In sessions facilitated by Cable and Division Lead Wellness Teacher Pam Verhoeff, the students spent the morning working together to foster leadership skills, engagement, and collaborative problem-solving.

They listened to an amazing speaker, Jesse Lipscombe, who advised them to not only use their passions and strengths to burn brightly and inspire others, but also to speak up when they see discriminatory behavior taking place.

In the afternoon, the students engaged in face-to-face dialogue with the Board of Trustees, and gave their honest answers on the pressing questions and issues surrounding their schools. Their responses are being compiled, and will be used to inform future decisions and the structure of next year's planned student leadership symposium.

"This was an amazing and inspiring day," said Verhoeff. "These students are working so hard to create change in their buildings and inspire their peers, and today they were reminded of the strength of their voices and the stretch of their impact, especially when they work together."

"I had goosebumps constantly listening to both the students and the teachers, who were completely open and vulnerable in their sharing," she added. "The day could not have gone better, and we are so very grateful to all who were in attendance."


