## NP CLINIC INCREASES HOURS AT THORSBY LOCATION

May 28, 2024 Media Release from Primary Care Network

The Leduc Beaumont Devon Primary Care Network (PCN) Nurse Practitioner clinics in Thorsby and Warburg have been open since 2020. The clinic operates four days a week out of two sites and has successfully met the primary care needs of the local population.

As a ground-floor office, the Thorsby Nurse Practitioner Clinic has seen an increase in demand for patients with mobility concerns. Additionally, the Thorsby site is colocated with Alberta Health Services (AHS) and is preferred by patients who need additional health services. As a result, the PCN will shift a clinic day and increase the Thorsby's clinic to three days per week.

Starting June 3, 2024, the Thorsby Nurse Practitioner Clinic will be open on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays, while the Warburg Nurse Practitioner Clinic will be open on Wednesdays. Patients will continue to be seen at their preferred location, and access to the Nurse Practitioner will continue to exceed standards. The PCN will monitor appointment availability at both sites and adjust schedules if needed.

The Warburg Nurse Practitioner Clinic, located in the basement of the Village of Warburg Municipal Office and Public Library, has an elevator patients can access through the Village office.





Keep an eye out in the mail for your 2024 tax notices. If you do not receive your notice in a timely manner, please feel free to come into the Town Office, with **proof of identification**, to receive a copy of your tax notice.

If you are waiting for land titles to process, please contact the Town Office as you may not receive your tax notice before June 30th.

If you are not a registered land title holder of a property, subject to FOIP, the Town will be unable to provide information regarding **tax notices**. These are not the same as tax assessments, which is publicly available information and can be found on the Town website.

Please note taxes are due on June 30th of every year.

If you are looking for a way to spread out payments over time, with <u>no penalties</u>, signing up for the Tax Installment Plan (TIPS) can be done at any time over at the Town Office during regular business hours. Feel free to call the office for more information on how the Tax Installment Plan (TIPS) can help you with taxes every year.

If you make your tax payments online, please remember to give **2-3 business days** for the payment to reach us. The Town **does not** take tax payments via credit card. Thank you very much!





#### 2024 LEDUC COUNTY REGIONAL SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD (QUASI-JUDICIAL BOARD)

The Leduc County Regional Subdivision and Development Appeal Board (LCRSDAB) is an independent, quasi-judicial board that adjudicates hearings on appeals from affected parties relative to decisions made by the subdivision authority and the development authority – similar to a court hearing. The LCRSDAB makes their decision on fact-based evidence, then applies legal rules as per legislation and planning documents such as the Municipal Development Plan and the Land-Use Bylaw.

When the SDAB makes its decision, it's final and cannot be overturned unless the SDAB makes a law or jurisdictional error.

All board members must successfully complete a training program set or approved by the Minister of Alberta Municipal Affairs.



# <u>NURSE</u> PRACTITIONER FAQ

After consultation with the Thorsby and Warburg Physician Attraction and Retention Committee, the Leduc Beaumont Devon Primary Care Network hired a Nurse Practitioner to provide health care support to the underserviced communities of Thorsby and Warburg. This was made possible through the Nurse Practitioner Support Program grant provided by the Government of Alberta. The Warburg Nurse Practitioner Clinic opened in June, 2020; the Thorsby Nurse Practitioner Clinic opened August 2020.

#### What is a Nurse Practitioner?

Nurse practitioners (NPs) are registered nurses with graduate education and training in advanced clinical practice. After receiving a degree as a Registered Nurse, Nurse Practitioners continue their education and obtain a Graduate degree and receive additional advanced clinical training.

They conduct comprehensive health assessment, diagnose health conditions, and treat and manage acute and chronic illness within a holistic model of care. NPs order and interpret screening and diagnostic tests, perform procedures, and prescribe medications (no restrictions) and therapeutic interventions and can refer to specialists.

Nurse practitioners act as primary care providers within their stream of practice. They work independently across the spectrum of health services, such as acute care, primary care, community health, long-term care, specialty areas of health and emergency care. They work collaboratively with physicians and other health care professionals to provide high-quality, patient-centred care.

Nurse practitioners use a holistic approach to health care, focusing not only on medical issues or problems, but also on patient/family-centered care including the psychosocial and functional aspects of life. Nurse practitioners provide patient education, health promotion, and involve patients in care. They have been shown to consistently have high rates of patient satisfaction with similar health outcomes when compared to the care provided by a family physician. Additionally, nurse practitioners provide timely access to care, especially in rural areas, relieving wait times and healthcare costs.

# What is the difference between a nurse practitioner and a family doctor?

Education is the main difference. Family doctors are trained in medical school followed by a clinical residency. Nurse practitioners have at least five years of nursing experience, followed by a masters-level degree with a certain number of hands on training hours in family practice.

The scope of practice for both a nurse practitioner and a family doctor are very similar, with the exception of a nurse practitioner not having surgical privileges in a hospital.

# What is the LBD PCN Nurse Practitioner's background?

The LBD PCN Nurse Practitioner is trained as a family/all

ages NP and has been practicing as a Registered Nurse for 20 years prior to obtaining her Nurse Practitioner graduate degree. She has spent most of her career in rural healthcare in the community of Whitecourt and surrounding areas working in the emergency department, acute care, labour and delivery, and public health settings. She has previously worked at the McLeod River Primary Care Network where she developed a palliative care program. Some of you may have already met her through her most recent experience as a Palliative Nurse Consultant seeing patients in the communities of Thorsby, Warburg, Calmar, Devon, Leduc and Beaumont, as well as in the local rural hospitals.

# Is the Nurse Practitioner a member of the LBD PCN?

Yes, the Nurse Practitioner is a member of the LBD PCN and as her patient, you are now also a member of the LBD PCN. This means the Nurse Practitioner can access the services of any of the PCNs healthcare providers, programs and services and you, as a patient of the NP, have access to all the healthcare providers, programs and services offered at the LBD PCN.

The LBD PCN Nurse Practitioner will maintain her own patient panel and have an agreement with the patient that they are the patient's only primary care provider.

#### Where will the Nurse Practitioner work?

The Thorsby Nurse Practitioner Clinic is located within the Thorsby Community Health Centre at 4825 Hankin Street; the Warburg Nurse Practitioner Clinic is located in the basement of the Village of Warburg Municipal Office and Public Library at 5212 50 Avenue.

#### What will their hours be?

Thorsby location – Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays Warburg location - Wednesdays

# Who can access the services of the Nurse Practitioner?

Any person who lives in or near the communities of Thorsby or Warburg who is not currently attached to a family doctor can access the services of the Nurse Practitioner.

#### Is the Nurse Practitioner accepting patients?

The Nurse Practitioner is currently not accepting new patients. We are working to increase access to these clinics.

#### Why should I have a primary care provider?

The best thing a patient can do for their own health is to have one primary provider, such as a nurse practitioner, and see that provider whenever possible. This is called continuity of care.

Continuity of care has been shown to:

- Improve health outcomes
- Improved patient satisfaction
- Decrease hospitalization
- Decrease time spent in hospital

When patients have a longitudinal relationship with a single provider, results are better for:

- Access
- · Quality of care
- Reduced overall health care system utilization and costs

When providers have knowledge of patient's comprehensive medical information, it results in better handoffs, better communication and less duplication of care.


