## THE HISTORY OF FARMER'S DAY IN ALBERTA

At one time Alberta children got to stay home from school on the second Friday in June to celebrate Farmer's Day.

Kevin Hoppins, UFA Board chairman, remembers those days fondly, but often wondered, "Why my urban classmates also got the day off school as this was Farmer's Day?"

"On our farm, having a day off of school for "Farmer's Day" meant that the crop had been seeded or that the spraying was yet to start. So this day offered a rest in between the busy farming season. As time passed I realized this significant day wasn't just for farmers— it was about the need to honour agriculture in the province, "explains Hoppins.

Hoppins said that the roots of Farmer's Day in Alberta can be traced back as far as 1914, when the Roseview (near Carbon, Alberta) local chapter of UFA hosted an annual gathering called 'UFA Sunday'. The purpose was to provide local UFA members, regardless of their religious affiliations, an opportunity "to join in a religious service, as it was considered that by showing the similarity in aims of the church and the farmers' organization, good-will and co-operation would be promoted."

The idea soon spread and was adopted as a provincewide event at UFA's 1918 conference. The tradition continued for many years and in time included athletic events, speeches, sing-alongs and evening dances.

By the 1940s there were calls within the organization to expand the celebration to engage all Albertans in celebrating the contributions of farmers to the province. At the 1945 UFA Annual Convention, the co-operative passed a resolution that would fix a date "to be observed as 'Farmers' Day' in Alberta on which day our Locals shall be asked to arrange suitable functions throughout the Province designed to remind us of the importance of our industry and our Organization." UFA then began lobbying the Alberta government for a day which recognized Alberta farmers' contributions. In 1951, Premier Ernest Manning's Social Credit Government proclaimed Friday, June 8 a school holiday to be observed as a Farmers' Holiday. For many years, the Alberta government would continue to proclaim one Friday in June to be a school holiday in recognition of farmers.

In 1975, the Alberta School Act was amended to allow school boards an option to declare a Farmers' Day school holiday on the second Friday of June in any year. This amendment remains part of the School Act to this day. In 2010, UFA Co-operative Limited revived the tradition of celebrating Farmer's Day at our UFA Farm and Ranch Supply Stores and Petroleum Agencies, honouring Alberta's agricultural producers, families and members of rural communities with picnics, games and music.



#### June 4, 2024 Regular Council Meeting

#### 2024 Schedule of Fees

Council approved the 2024 Schedule of Fees, with some changes from the previous schedule:

- Brazeau County flags will now be sold at actual cost, approximately \$160
- Afire suppression trailer has been added to the rental fleet
- The damage deposit for no spray signs has been removed
- All cemetery fees associated with grave opening/ closing have been eliminated

#### **AG-16 Conference Reports Policy**

Council approved the AG-16 Conference Reports Policy, which requires Agricultural Service Board members to provide a written report, to be included in the ASB meeting agenda, following attendance at a conference. The policy was forwarded to Council from the Agricultural Service Board for approval.

#### **RCMP Update**

Staff Sergeant Dwayne Moore of the Breton Detachment and Sergeant Ryan Hoetmer of the Drayton Valley Detachment presented detachment updates.

In Drayton Valley, there has been a 30% increase in total Criminal Code offenses for the period of January to March when compared to the same period in 2023, with 121 offenses this year compared to 93 in 2023.

In Breton, total Criminal Code offenses have risen 6% when comparing the January to March 2024 time period to the same period in 2023, with 161 offenses in 2024, compared to 152 last year.

**Director of Emergency Management** Council welcomed Emergency Management Coordinator Ryan Barbazuk, who will act as the Director of Emergency Management in an emergency situation, and will provide leadership and training for County staff.




### BLAST FROM THE PAST BRETON HISTORY Hugh Impey

## ENHANCING PUBLIC SAFETY WITH FIRE SERVICE GRANTS

June 3, 2024 Alberta News

#### Alberta's government is supporting a new research initiative to gather fire services data that will help municipalities strengthen public safety in Alberta.

Firefighters across Alberta play a critical role in the public safety of communities. Besides fighting fires, municipal firefighters provide first response to medical emergencies and other disasters, conduct search and rescue operations, and educate the public about fire safety and prevention.

Investing in services that support municipalities in strengthening public safety is a top priority for the government. Strong partnerships are key to keeping Albertans safe, which includes keeping firefighters safe. To help with that ongoing work, Alberta's government is providing grants totalling \$700,000 to municipalities and the Alberta Fire Chiefs Association (AFCA) for research and training.

It is vital that local fire services are equipped to respond safely and effectively to all emergencies, and firefighters are able to receive training in alignment with industry best practices. To ensure this, Alberta's government provides ongoing support to municipal fire services through annual grants for fire services training. A total of \$500,000 in grants through the Fire Services Training Program is provided each year to help fire departments cover costs such as fire services course fees and training materials. All municipalities, Metis Settlements, and First Nations communities in Alberta are eligible for these grants, which help prepare firefighters with the knowledge and skills they need to protect their communities.

Fire hazards, risks and responses change regularly and it is absolutely critical that local firefighters have all the information they need to be able to respond quickly, safely and efficiently. Research is needed to help local firefighting experts identify the specific data they need, the best ways to collect it, and how municipalities can use it to mitigate risks.

To accomplish this work, a one-time \$200,000 grant will help the Alberta Fire Chiefs Association to research and develop recommendations for how to strengthen provincial fire data reporting. Improving the quality of fire data reporting will put municipal leaders in a better position to make well-informed decisions about local fire services and protection strategies for their communities.

"We are encouraged by the Alberta Government's commitment to supporting the AFCA's Fire Services

Data project, which involves researching a fire services data mechanism to enable data-driven decision-making. The \$200,000 grant to enhance fire data reporting is a testament to the power of collaboration between the government and fire services." Randy Schroeder, president, Alberta Fire Chiefs Association

## LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

#### To the Editor:

A letter to the editor from a Drayton Valley resident raised some concerns that he has about his tax increase this year. The following represents a small response to his questions.

He states that the Town pays \$2.27 million for RCMP services; Omniplex, \$.97 million. Please note that the County contributes approximately \$1.2 million (half the cost) to recreation; about \$1 million to RCMP; a one-time payment of about \$800,000 to the Eleanor Pickup Centre; \$100,000 to Rotary building.

The Farmer Report (of a few years ago) stated that Brazeau County donates about \$150 per person to Drayton Valley recreation, whereas the citizens in the rest of the province donate about \$37 per person in their municipalities. Come to your own conclusions. Note that facility usage numbers have never been provided

Don't be fooled by the *"lack of increase"* in taxes by the County. They have recently overspent their revenues by some \$35 million with the result that most (if not all) reserve accounts are virtually depleted. As a result, the number of hours for machinery and equipment has been increased by 1500 hours per machine before trade in. This, of course, will cost taxpayers extra for maintenance as well as reduced trade-in value. Benefit to the County? In addition, the UCP has since reduced the linear tax base to the County.

This writer has heard it stated that County finances are "good" because we own some gravel and have a paid-for county building. Neither of these items pay a single salary or maintain a mile of road. Here again, come to your own conclusions!

The County recently spent about \$9 million for the primary benefit of 56 people in Cynthia. Why are the rest of county taxpayers paying for their benefit? Should there not be a *"local improvement tax"* for those that receive the benefit. Does Drayton Valley operate the same way?

The above account does not include the benefits to the Town from the County residents spending money in Drayton Valley. In addition, remember that the County gave virtually all their businesses to the Town several years ago.

Any concerns that the writer has could be taken up with the DV Town Council.
