



- 2. The items **must** be on your lawn by 8:00am on June 22nd.
- 3. Items **must** be on the registered list, or you get to keep them.
- 4. Items will not be picked up from Commercial or Businesses

Items that are **not registered** will not be picked up, so please **do not put extra waste on your lawns!** This is restricted to large item pickup; regular garbage will still be collected per usual every Thursday, and recycling collected every other Thursday per the available schedule.





NEXT STEPS IN REFOCUSED MENTAL HEALTH. ADDICTION CARE

Alberta's government is moving forward with establishing Recovery Alberta and the Canadian Centre of Recovery Excellence.

June 11, 2024 Alberta News

In April 2024, Alberta's government announced it was creating two new organizations to improve mental health and addiction care as part of refocusing health care in Alberta. Recovery Alberta will be the new provincial health agency to deliver mental health, addiction and correctional health services currently provided by Alberta Health Services (AHS). The Canadian Centre of Recovery Excellence (CoRE) will also be established to support Alberta's government with data analysis, program evaluation and research of global best practices to support evidence-based mental health and addiction services.

Government tabled legislation to create both organizations during the spring session and, in May, the Alberta legislature passed both the Health Statutes Amendment Act and the Canadian Centre of Recovery Excellence Act, enabling government to move forward with establishing Recovery Alberta and CoRE.

Updated timelines of Recovery Alberta

Once the final legislative processes are complete, Recovery Alberta is expected to be a legal entity as of July 1. Kerry Bales, Recovery Alberta's incoming chief executive officer will then establish a senior leadership team and begin implementing the corporate policies and processes required to facilitate the transition of Mental Health and Addiction, and Correctional Health Services from AHS to Recovery Alberta.

Alberta's government has been engaging with staff on the frontlines in leadership positions following the introduction and passing of the Health Statutes Amendment Act, and in response to that engagement, has updated the transition timeline. It is now expected programs and staff will transition to Recovery Alberta on September 1. Staff will continue to be engaged throughout this transition period and information will be shared as it becomes available.

Frontline workers and service providers remain essential to care for Albertans, and there will be no changes to terms of employment for current AHS staff transitioning to Recovery Alberta. An agreement in principle has been reached with the United Nurses of Alberta on the transition of registered nurses to Recovery Alberta. Additionally, there will be no changes to grants or contracts for service providers currently under agreement with AHS upon establishment of

Recovery Alberta.

The creation of Recovery Alberta prioritizes mental health and addiction services and ensures these services receive the attention and oversight needed to address the addiction crisis and better support those struggling with mental health challenges. Alberta's government will be able to better direct resources and improve the patient experience across the continuum of care, including prevention, intervention, treatment and recovery.

Canadian Centre of Recovery Excellence


In the past five years, Alberta has made significant strides in creating a system focused on recovery. Alberta's government has removed user fees for treatment, increased publicly funded treatment capacity and opened two recovery communities with nine more on the way. The province has also paved the way for helping those with addiction achieve recovery by making same day treatment and medication available at no cost across the province through the Virtual Opioid Dependency Program.

The Canadian Centre of Recovery Excellence is being established to improve mental health and addiction services through data analysis, program evaluation, research and advice to government. Following the completion of legislative processes, CoRE is expected to be established by the end of the month.

Quick facts

\$1.55 billion is being invested in 2024-25 to continue building the Alberta Recovery Model.

- This includes a \$1.13-billion funding transfer from Health to Mental Health and Addiction (MHA) for mental health and addiction services currently delivered by Alberta Health Services.
- \$5 million is being invested in 2024-25 to establish the Canadian Centre of Recovery Excellence.
- Virtual engagement sessions for AHS staff and service providers were held in April and recordings can be listened to online.
- Additional engagement for AHS Mental Health and Addiction and Correctional Health Services staff is being planned over the summer months.

PROJECT APOLLO

submitted by the Warburg Parent School Society

On a blustery but sunny Tuesday last week, Warburg Parent School Society hosted the Grand Opening Ceremony of the Apollo play structure, to celebrate and honour the volunteers and generous sponsors of Project Apollo. The event was held in Warburg School playground, beginning with a welcome from Principal of Warburg School Wendy Maltais, followed by photographs, the ribbon cutting performed by Rhett Binding & Anita Hagel of Sinopec, presentation of certificates and then to the courtyard for light refreshments and viewing of the sponsorship "thank you" sign, created by CE Media in Thorsby. In attendance were many of the sponsors, volunteers, students and staff from the Elementary school.

During her "welcome", Mrs Maltais gave a brief history of Project Apollo. It has been a multi-year project that started in the spring of 2019 when a dedicated group of parent volunteers—the Warburg Parent School Society—decided to fundraise for a piece of playground equipment to fill the space left behind where a set of old swings had been removed.

The Covid-19 pandemic slowed down progress drastically throughout 2020, 2021 & part of 2022 but the society slowly found its feet again. Although they increased the amount of fundraisers at the school, they realized quickly that they could not rely solely upon school families to fund this \$40K+ project.

"In 2022, we started applying for grants and we had a parent volunteer to create a sponsorship package for us so we could approach local businesses for support. This is when our project really started to gain traction.

We were blown away with the Community response to our sponsorships and we were able to raise the 50% matching funds required in order to apply for the Government of Alberta's Community Facility Enhancement Program (CFEP) grant in September 2022.

In March of 2023, we were notified that our CFEP application was successful. We ordered our equipment in April 2023, which had a very long lead time.

The equipment finally arrived the last week of August 2023, with installation complete on the second day that kids were back to school. The kids were so excited to have a new piece of equipment to play on, it was a great Welcome Back gift for them

This was an ambitious project for our small school. We learned a lot and we are super proud of our efforts. It is incredibly rewarding to see life brought back to our playground as the kids laugh and play on the new equipment."


Thank you once more to all our sponsors, volunteers, community members and school families who supported



"GRANDPARENT SCAMS"

ITS NOT JUST GRANDPARENTS AFFECTED

June 11, 2024 Media Relations RCMP

RCMP are advising the public that there has been an increase in the number of "Grandparent Scams" reported to the Detachment this month. These scams are also referred to as "Emergency Scams" or "Grandchild" scams.

No matter the name, these scams often involve a phone call being placed to the victim claiming a loved one is in trouble with the courts or law enforcement, and a payment is needed to help them. The suspects will often pretend to be a police officer, judge, or family member. Suspects will usually ask for cash, however more recently they have been asking for payment by Bitcoin and gift cards.

RCMP want to remind citizens of the following:

- Never send or give money to anyone you don't know or haven't confirmed their identity
- Bail is always paid in person at a courthouse or correctional centre, and is never in the form of giftcards or BitCoin
- If a person claims to be a police officer or judge, call that police service or court house directly to confirm the situation and identity of the caller
- Never give out personal information over the phone or online to someone you don't know
- If you receive a call from someone saying they are a
 friend or family member and they need emergency
 money, hang up and call them yourself to ensure the
 person is who they say they are. Fraudsters have the
 ability to change their caller id information to say
 anything they want. With new technology, there are
 also applications that can mimic the voice of anyone.

Police are asking the public to speak to their friends and family, of all ages, about these scams to help spread awareness and education. Though these particular scams have historically been aimed at the elderly, RCMP advise the age of victims is now a broad range from young teenagers, young adults, to the elderly.

RCMP encourage the public to visit The Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre www.antifraudcentre-centreantifraude.ca to familiarize themselves with the many different types of scams out there, as well as to access information and resources to share with family and friends.

NEW REPORT SLAMS FEDERAL ELECTRICITY PLANS

June 11, 2024 Alberta News

Premier Danielle Smith and Minister of Environment and Protected Areas Rebecca Schulz issued the following statement on the Canada Electricity Advisory Council's final report:

"The Canada Electricity Advisory Council's latest report echoes Alberta's long-standing warning: Ottawa's onesize-fits-all electricity regulations are a dangerous, costly and unrealistic path to failure.

"For over two years, provinces, utilities, businesses and Canadians have demanded federal electricity regulations that reduce emissions without sacrificing affordability and reliability. Yet the federal government has stubbornly stuck to its plans to implement unrealistic targets for a net-zero grid by 2035, regardless of the costs and risks to Albertans.

"Now the federal government's own expert advisory body is sounding the alarm. The Canada Electricity Advisory Council is calling for less ideology and more common sense, rejecting rigid mandates that ignore regional realities. Alberta is rapidly decarbonizing its grid, but we refuse to gamble with winter blackouts and crippling energy bills.

"This federally appointed committee recognizes that the arbitrary 2035 deadline is unrealistic and unattainable – and has instead recommended that the federal government support the development of provincial and territorial energy roadmaps for a net-zero or carbonneutral energy system by 2050.

"We urge the federal government to listen to this report and to the many concerns raised by Canadians, industry and provinces across the country. Abandon the reckless 2035 targets and partner with us to build a modern, reliable and affordable electricity grid that truly serves Canadians.

"Alberta already has a plan to reach carbon neutrality by 2050 – the federal government should work with us to achieve this goal."
