

BREAKING NEWS!!

FIRE ADVISORY UPGRADED TO A RESTRICTION FOR THE TOWN OF THORSBY

Due to hot, dry conditions, there is an increased risk of wildfires; therefore, effective immediately, the Town of Thorsby is no longer under a fire advisory. The fire advisory has been upgraded to a fire restriction.

What does this mean?

- No open fires are allowed, and all open fires must be extinguished immediately.
- Citizens can use cooking and heating appliances - such as barbecues, firepits, and patio heaters - fueled by liquid fuel like propane or natural gas.
- Citizens can also use <u>approved burn</u> <u>barrels and firepits</u>, but should use extreme caution and ensure they have water close by.

The Town of Thorsby will continue to monitor conditions and will update the public on the Town of Thorsby website,



The staff and board of the Thorsby Municipal Library want to thank everyone for your kindness and patience as we have navigated the extreme heat of the last couple of weeks. With closures and unusual hours we hugely appreciate your graciousness in accommodating the disruptions to library service.

Even in these scorching times, the library has resources to help you stay cool. We have cookbooks like "Smoothies for Kids" and "Easy No Churn Ice Cream" with recipes to help beat the heat. We have kits, from a DS with games through a domino racecourse, and a variety of board games for all ages for those too hot indoor afternoons. And of course we have books, fiction and non-fiction, that will help you escape to a cooler place.

Our Summer Reading Program, "To the Stars" is flying right along. We have had astral fun in the arena, explored myth busting science, and enjoyed a space voyage mini camp. Coming up... Next Wednesday morning at 10:00 am, Alien Adventures! Come dressed as your favourite alien and build your own alien spacecraft!

And now... From the summer reading program archives... One of our most fun experiments! **Clear Slime!**

This worked so well, we just had to share the recipe. Note: everything used is washable.

Materials:

- 1/2 cup clear school glue
- 1 thsp cheapest contact lens solution (must contain boric acid)
- ½ cup hot but not boiling water
- ½ teaspoon baking soda
- (glitter if desired)
- 2 bowls for mixing
- Stirring implements

Procedure:

- Measure ½ cup clear glue into mixing bowl
- Add 1 tbsp contact lens solution
- Stir until well mixed.
- In a second bowl,
- Measure ½ cup hot water
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- Stir until the baking soda is totally dissolved
- Gently pour the water mixture over the glue mixture.
- Let it sit for about 1 minute.
- Stir it up until it starts to ball up, and knead it (work it with your hands)

- It will be very sticky, but the more you knead it, the more elastic and non-sticky it will become.
- Add glitter at any time and knead it in if you want sparkly slime.
- Store your slime in a small airtight container to keep it fresh.
- To refresh your slime, dissolve ½ teaspoon of baking soda in ½ cup of hot water.
- Pour the old slime into the water mixture and stir and knead as before.
- Discard the excess water and enjoy your reactivated slime.

BLUE-GREEN ALGAE ADVISORY ISSUED FOR WIZARD LAKE

Alberta Health Services - Health Advisory - July 19, 2024

Cyanobacteria (blue-green algae) has been identified in the waters of Wizard Lake, the south shores of which are located in the Central Zone. Residents living near the shores of this lake, as well as visitors to this lake, are advised to take the following precautions:

- Avoid all contact with cyanobacterial blooms. If contact occurs, wash with tap water as soon as possible.
- Do not swim or wade or allow your pets to swim or wade in any areas where cyanobacteria is visible.
- Do not feed whole fish or fish trimmings from this lake to your pets.
- Consider limiting human consumption of whole fish and fish trimmings from this lake, as it is known that fish may store toxins in their liver. (People can safely consume fish fillets from this lake).

As always, visitors and residents are reminded to never drink or cook with untreated water directly from any recreational body of water, including Wizard Lake, at any time. Boiling of this water will not remove the toxins produced by cyanobacteria. An alternate source of drinking water should also be provided for pets and livestock, while this advisory is active.

Cyanobacteria is naturally occurring, and often becomes visible when weather conditions are calm. Appearing like

scum, grass clippings, fuzz, or globs on the surface of water, cyanobacteria can be bluegreen, greenish-brown, brown, and/or pinkish-red, and often smell musty or grassy.



People who come in contact with visible cyanobacteria or who ingest water containing cyanobacteria may experience skin irritation, rash, sore throat, sore red eyes, swollen lips, fever, nausea and vomiting and/or diarrhea. Symptoms usually appear within one to three hours and resolve in one to two days. Symptoms in children are often more pronounced; however, all humans are at risk of these symptoms. Exposure to the bacteria may be fatal to pets.

Weather and wind conditions can cause algae blooms to move from one location in the lake to another. As such, this advisory will remain in effect for Wizard Lake, until further notice.

Please note that waters of Wizard Lake in which the cyanobacterial bloom is NOT visible can still be used for recreational purposes, even while this Health Advisory is

in place.

If you suspect a problem related to cyanobacteria or if you require further information on health concerns and cyanobacteria, please call Health Link at 811. Additional information is also available online, at www.ahs.ca/bga.

DO YOU REMEMBER WHEN?

On July 11, 1979, the Thorsby Homecoming Committee compiled a newspaper in honor of Thorsby's 50th Anniversary celebration July 13 - 15, 1979. Over the next few months, we will share with you some of the stories, picture, ads and information.

Here is the second story....

Thorsby Electric expands as town grows

By S.D. Tomaszeski

Doug Milner and his wife journeyman's certificate Effie began operating an electrical contracting business in Calmar in 1946 under the name of Calmar Electric. The business was operated from their house.

In 1947 they hired their first apprentice, which was myself (S.D. Tomaszeski). The wage I received was 75 cents per hour.

One year later they hired another apprentice, Melvin Metke. At that time there was no power in the rural areas other than those who had their own power plants.

After four years in Calmar, Mr. Milner decided to make a move elsewhere, so he thought he would try Thorsby. On April 25, 1950 he received authorization from the Village of Thorsby to move his business there. We made the move on July 1, 1950.

The first shop was opened in the newly built Thorsby Theatre. After a couple of years there, we moved into the Hale building, where Mr. Hale operated a machinery agency selling Oliver and Minneapolis Moline machinery. We shared the building and sold machinery parts for Mr. Hale, also operating the gas pumps.

In 1952 I received my journeyman's certificate after attending school at Calgary's Canadian Vocational School. N.A.I.T. did not exist at that


time. As soon as I received my certificate I bought onehalf share of the business, thus starting a partnership with Mr. Milner. We worked together for several years until Mr. Milner decided to move back to Edmonton. He went back to his wartime job with North West Industries.

I carried on the partnership until July, 1959 when I purchased Mr. Milner's share in the business, thus dissolving the partnership. The Hale building was sold to John Kolesar so we continued to share the building with the new owners for a few years.

When Arthur Harrish decided to close his Massey-Ferguson Agency, we purchased the building from him. We moved into our own building then and operated from there until 1973, when we purchased the Faraschuk building. In April of 1973 we moved to this building, keeping the old building as a warehouse. The new building is used as an appliance store and electrical contracting.

At the present time, we have four journeyman electricians and one apprentice, with Mrs. Sophia Pruneau as clerk and bookkeeper. Mrs. Pruneau joined us in 1963, thus completing 15 years with us this year (1978).

Some of our apprentices who went on to get their journeyman certificates were Melvin Metke, Bert Sparrow, Harry Pichonsky, Eugene Fedor, Les Bacsik, Albert Heidt, Orest Senio, Ken Dublanko and Julian Tomaszeski.


