

BLUE-GREEN ALGAE ADVISORY ISSUED FOR PIGEON LAKE

Alberta Health Services - Health Advisory - July 31, 2024

Cyanobacteria (blue-green algae) has been identified in the waters of Pigeon Lake. Residents living near the shores of this lake, as well as visitors to this lake, are advised to take the following precautions:

- Avoid all contact with cyanobacterial blooms. If contact occurs, wash with tap water as soon as possible.
- Do not swim or wade or allow your pets to swim or wade in any areas where cyanobacteria is visible.
- **Do not feed** whole fish or fish trimmings from this lake to your pets.
- Consider limiting human consumption of whole fish and fish trimmings from this lake, as it is known that fish may store toxins in their liver. (People can safely consume fish fillets from this lake).

As always, visitors and residents are reminded to never drink or cook with untreated water directly from any recreational body of water, including Wizard Lake, at any time. Boiling of this water will <u>not</u> remove the toxins produced by cyanobacteria. An alternate source of drinking water should also be provided for pets and livestock, while this advisory is active.

Cyanobacteria is naturally occurring, and often becomes visible when weather conditions are calm. Appearing like scum, grass clippings, fuzz, or globs on the surface of water, cyanobacteria can be blue-green, greenish-brown, brown, and/or pinkish-red, and often smell musty or grassy.

People who come in contact with visible cyanobacteria or who ingest water containing cyanobacteria may experience skin irritation, rash, sore throat, sore red eyes, swollen lips, fever, nausea and vomiting and/or diarrhea. Symptoms usually appear within one to three hours and resolve in one to two days. Symptoms in children are often more pronounced; however, all humans are at risk of these symptoms. Exposure to the bacteria may be fatal to pets.

Weather and wind conditions can cause algae blooms to

move from one location in the lake to another. As such, this advisory will remain in effect for Pigeon Lake, until further notice.

Please note that waters of Pigeon Lake in which the cyanobacterial bloom is **NOT** visible can still be used for recreational purposes, even while this Health Advisory is in place.

DO YOU REMEMBER WHEN?

On July 11, 1979, the Thorsby Homecoming Committee compiled a newspaper in honor of Thorsby's 50th Anniversary celebration July 13 - 15, 1979. Over the next few months, we will share with you some of the stories, picture, ads and information. Here is the third story....

The Mudry Lumber Saga

The Mudry Lumber Co. has a history dating back to the early 1900's. Dan and Eva Mudry came to the area in 1900 and settled on a raw quarter of land in what would become the Dniester school district a short while later.


Their sons became actively involved in the lumbering business and the Mudry Sawmill operated for many years. Their sons Mike, Lue, Tom and Fred all worked in it and were also carpenters. Many of the early schools were built by

contracts let out to Lue Mudry.

When the homesteaders were able to build better homes for their families, the Mudry brothers were sought for their carpentering knowledge. When the railroad extended eastward from Breton and made the founding of Thorsby possible, the Mudry family was on the spot to establish a business.

Fred built his lumber yard and office and opened for business and this has continued continuously throughout the past 50 years on the same site. His business grew and when his only son Joe became old enough he joined his father and they have expanded it. In 1979 their premises are attractively maintained and serve a very wide trading area, the F. Mudry and Son Co. Ltd.

Dan and Eva Mudry's family have spread and their descendants can be found engaged in many types of work in various parts of western Canada. They had two daughters, one remains in Thorsby (Mrs. Fanny Samardzic). The other, Anne, made her home in Calgary and died there a few years ago.

SOWING SEEDS OF SUCCESS FOR FUTURE FARMERS

July 30, 2024 Alberta News

Alberta's government is supporting future farmers and ranchers through changes to Agriculture Financial Services Corporation's Next Generation Loan program.

Agriculture is essential to Alberta's history, economy and future prosperity. Over the past 20 years, the number of young and middle-aged producers in agriculture has seen steep declines, while the number of farmers over 55 has increased. Alberta's government is aiming to help reverse that trend with changes to Agriculture Financial Services Corporation (AFSC)'s Next Generation Loan Program (Next Gen).

Alberta's government understands that producers need stable sources of capital to manage and grow their operations and help them weather economic challenges. Expanding eligibility and updating Next Gen's terms will make it easier for producers to enter and re-enter the agriculture industry, give greater opportunities to new and growing operations, make succession more appealing, and encourage new and young people to get into farming.

"By updating and expanding the Next Generation Loan program, young and young-at-heart Albertans will have fewer barriers when entering Alberta's agriculture industry. Increasing new and returning entrants to agriculture will ensure the sector continues to be a healthy and important contributor to Alberta's economy." RJ Sigurdson, Minister of Agriculture and Irrigation

Next Gen already offers preferential pricing with the lowest interest rates compared to all other loan programs in the ag lending market. The updates will expand eligibility for interest rate incentives, lower ownership percentage requirements and increase the time available for "interest-only" loan payments.

"The changes to the Next Generation Loan program are key to the long-term sustainability and growth of Alberta's agriculture industry. I'm proud that AFSC will be here to assist these new and beginning farmers as they get started in farming and build on the work of earlier generations." Darryl Kay, CEO, Agriculture Financial Services Corporation

With updates to the Next Generation Loan Program:

- Producers of any age who are entering or returning to farming are eligible for a one per cent interest rate incentive, while before it was only available to those under age 40.
- Producers may receive an interest rate incentive on their total lifetime loan principal up to \$1.5 million, an

increase from the previous \$1 million.

- Applicants now require 20 per cent ownership in a farming operation, down from 25 per cent.
- Eligible borrowers can make "interest-only" payments on their loans for up to five years, up from the current two years.

These changes will take effect September 1. Interested producers can talk to their AFSC branch to find out more.

" Succession planning is front of mind for farmers,



especially as we expect to see a growing number of farms transition to the next generation over the next several years. Programs, like this that help reduce barriers for new and next generation farmers, help to ensure the viability of the crop sector in Alberta into the future." Scott Jespersen, vice-chair, Alberta Grains


