

GRAVEL CYCLING EVENT COMING TO THORSBY AND WESTERN LEDUC COUNTY!

Get ready for **Festivus of Gravel on Saturday, August 17**, a day of gravel cycling starting and finishing in Thorsby at the Arctic Spas Rec Centre. The theme is "The Battle of Thor". There are 4 distances for the riders who take part in this event:

- 295 km and 190 km distances start together at 07:00
- 105 km riders start at 08:00
- 55 km riders start at 10:00

Riders will be finishing between 12 Noon and 5:00PM...with some even finishing in the evening.

At the finish line, we are planning a festival of cycling where all are welcome with bike shops and their partners showing their wares as well as local vendors. There will be food for purchase, as well as a beer garden for any and all - riders and spectators alike. We hope everyone in Thorsby can come out and enjoy the festivities!

What exactly is a gravel cycling event? Gravel cycling is all about installing a sense of adventure as participants self-navigate a prescribed course over gravel roads. Each rider is provided with a GPS file for their specific course that they follow.

Someone is using CPO Dejan Cvijetić's information which is illegal.

All fines, fees, or payments related to remedial orders or any enforcement actions are processed through official channels and should never be paid directly to an officer.

I would appreciate it if you could spread the word to residents and reinforce that any such requests for money are fraudulent. Residents should be advised to contact the local enforcement office or the RCMP immediately if they receive any suspicious calls.

Let's ensure our community remains informed and protected from this scam. Thank you for your cooperation and vigilance in addressing this issue."

Eligibility

Residents of Leduc County, Calmar, Thorsby, and Warburg who meet the specific income thresholds may be eligible for subsidy.

Residents must meet two criteria to be eligible for subsidy:

- 1. Gross family household income less than \$75,000.00 AND
- 2. No access to employee insurance benefits

Sessions and rates

Each household approved for free subsidized counselling may choose from the following options:

- 3 individual sessions per person, or
- ► 6 couple sessions, or
- 9 family sessions, or
- 7 group sessions per person.

Seniors Assisted Transportation Subsidy Frequently asked questions

The cost of transportation can be a barrier for many of our rural seniors. Leduc County provides a subsidy to eligible older adults (65+) who need transportation for medical appointments. Leduc County believes rural residents should have the resources to age in place and will support older adults to access those needed services, including transportation to and from appointments. Transportation services are provided by volunteers of Drive Happiness.



I'm a senior and I still drive. Is this program for me?

Become a volunteer driver. Many of our volunteer drivers are seniors. If you like driving and have time to give, consider becoming a volunteer for Drive Happiness. Most rides are scheduled on weekdays.

Become a rider. Sometimes people should not or cannot drive after certain medical appointments or treatments. Some people feel very confident driving in their own community or on their usual routes; however, if a trip requires you to go to an unfamiliar area or a busy city, you may not feel as comfortable. Becoming a rider with Drive Happiness doesn't mean you never drive; it just means that sometimes you need a ride.

I'm a senior between the ages of 65 and 79, but I don't have a lot of medical appointments. I'd like to use services for shopping or running errands. Is this program for me?

Seniors in this age category eligible for this program are allotted five free roundtrip rides for medical appointments. If you need a ride for other reasons, you can still use the program by purchasing ride tickets.

I'm a senior, and I have a lot of medical appointments. What if I exceed the number of rides allotted?

Your approval for rides will be based on your age – five free roundtrip rides for ages 65-79 and 10 free roundtrip

rides for ages 80+. You are welcome to purchase ride tickets for more.

If I need to pay for tickets myself, how much are tickets? How many tickets will I need to purchase for my ride?

Each ride is assessed by Drive Happiness for distance and time to determine the number of tickets required. You'll always know how much the ride will cost before agreeing to it. Because Volunteer Happiness is a non-profit organization who uses volunteers, affordability is a key consideration!


I'd like to volunteer, but fuel is expensive! Do I need extra vehicle insurance?

You will be volunteering your time as a driver, and you can sign up for as many or as few rides as you'd like to. As a volunteer, you will receive a mileage reimbursement. If you are needing to run your own errand anyway, this could pay for your trip to do so!

As per the Insurance Bureau of Canada, volunteer drivers are not required to have additional insurance coverage beyond the recommended liability coverage of \$1 million.

ALBERTA'S DROUGHT RESPONSE PLAN

Alberta News, August 14, 2024

Alberta's updated drought response plan will help Albertans better understand and respond to drought conditions in their communities.

In May, Alberta released the 2024 Drought Response Plan with the entire province placed in Stage 4, the second-highest stage. Since then, some areas have seen significant rains, while others are still experiencing droughts and water shortages. With conditions varying, a more targeted approach is needed.

Alberta's government has released a new, updated Drought Response Plan that classifies drought stages by river basin, while continuing to help make sure that Albertans, communities, farmers, ranchers and businesses get the support they need, whatever the weather. The province continues monitoring drought conditions closely across Alberta.

"Drought conditions over the last two years have posed real challenges to communities, farmers and ranchers in some parts of the province. We're working to help improve Alberta's drought response, now and long into the future, by providing clearer information on local conditions to better manage water use." Rebecca Schulz, Minister of Environment and Protected Areas

Alberta's Drought Response Plan is a multi-stage roadmap, covering everything from conservation plans and water-sharing agreements to declaring an emergency and prioritizing water for human health and safety. The plan helps government, irrigators, communities, businesses and others respond quickly and effectively to a wide range of drought conditions.

The updated plan better reflects the conditions in each region. It assigns each region a ranking from Stage 0 (no drought conditions) to Stage 4 (significant drought conditions in multiple water management areas). The Oldman and Milk River basins remain at Stage 4 due to very dry conditions. However, the other basins have been downgraded to Stage 0, 1, 2 or 3 to reflect their current moisture levels. No basins are at Stage 5 (urgent and critical escalation of drought conditions leading to a water emergency declared under the *Water Act*).

Albertans can now see drought stages and check conditions in their area using the new online map.

Alberta's government will continue working to support local water users in any and all areas experiencing water issues. Regardless of classification, smaller areas within each basin can still experience water shortages or challenges separate from drought, and officials will provide support wherever needed.

Moving forward, drought classifications will be updated

as needed based on the weather conditions, water supply and demand. Regardless of drought stage, all Albertans are encouraged to consider ways to use water wisely. Conserving water is always a good habit and it helps your community, as well as communities downstream.

Quick facts

- The updated Drought Response Plan defines the same five stages of drought as the original plan but adds a Stage 0 for areas not experiencing drought conditions.
- Alberta's criteria for assessing the severity drought conditions and corresponding management actions has not changed. The only change is that each basin now receives its own specific conditions ranking.
 - The Oldman and Milk River basins remain at Stage 4, the drought response stage that previously applied to the entire province.
 - The Red Deer and Bow River basins and the southern tributaries of the South Saskatchewan are at Stage 3.
 - Areas in the northern half of the province are at Stage 1 or Stage 2, with the exception of the Beaver River basin, which is at Stage 0, meaning there are currently no drought conditions.
- In the future, government may also provide specific condition rankings to other sub-basins if it is needed to help Albertans to understand that drought conditions and response actions significantly differ from the rest of the basin.
- Other revisions to the Drought Response Plan include updates to better align with spring legislative amendments related to responding to an emergency declaration under Section 107 of the Water Act.
- Alberta's Drought Response Plan is intended to be a living document that is reviewed and routinely updated to better support the effective drought management in the province.
- As of Aug. 14, there are 36 water shortage advisories in place for select water management areas across Alberta

**Please note - according to the Alberta Drought Map, Leduc County area is in Stage 2 - Active Management.


