



September 9th is International FASD Day

First celebrated in 1999, FASD day is devoted to raising awareness of <u>fetal alcohol spectrum disorder (FASD)</u> to improve prevention of FASD and diagnosis and support for individuals with FASD.

Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) is a lifelong disability that affects the brain and body of people who were exposed to alcohol in the womb. Each person with FASD has both strengths and challenges and will need special supports to help them succeed with many different parts of their daily lives.

FASD FACTS:

- FASD impacts approximately <u>4%</u> of Canadians.
- FASD impacts more people in Canada than Autism Spectrum Disorder, Cerebral Palsy, and Down syndrome combined.
- Individuals with FASD are known for having a number of different <u>strengths</u>, including being friendly, likeable, affectionate, determined, hard-working, forgiving, non-judgemental and caring.
- 90% of individuals with FASD also experience mental health issues.
- The social and economic cost of FASD in Canada is estimated to be \$1.8 billion annually.
- · Individuals with FASD achieve positive outcomes if

their needs and challenges are addressed early on in life and they have access to supports that carry into adulthood.

Messages to support prevention

- Safest not to drink alcohol during pregnancy.
- Alcohol and pregnancy don't mix. If you drink alcohol and are sexually active, make sure you use effective contraception.
- Friends, partners and family members can support pregnant individuals by asking how they can help her make healthy choices and healthy babies.
- Serve mocktails, support an expected person by joining them in an alcohol free 9 months.



TAYLOR PARK / STATUE OF THOR HISTORY

by the Thorsby & District Chamber of Commerce

In the Spring of 2019, former Thorsby Economic Development coordinator, Carol Rempel had an idea to create an arts and cultural park in the downtown core. After speaking with former business owner Bob Taylor (Taylor Pharmacy), a wonderful gift was given to the community and Bob donated land to begin "Taylor Park".

In June 2019, former CAO Christine Burke wrote a letter of support "We are pleased to support the plans for the development of land to be known as Taylor Park, which through the efforts of local community groups will become a genuine asset and focal point for our community for many years to come, and a true community park in all aspects." Taylor Park fundraising and planning volunteer committee was formed and organized the first "Spirit of Thorsby" event on September 19, 2019. This very successful event raised \$9,251.45 towards the development of the park. There was a volunteer lead team of 6, 46 sponsors, over 50 volunteers and 19 vendors. The Spirit of Thorsby was one pure effort which was made to lay a solid foundation of the Taylor Park Journey.

A draft plan was drawn up by Nicolas Moffat from the Leduc County Parks and Recreation and was presented to council. It was moved by Council that they support the development of Taylor Park in principle based on the understanding there is no cost to the Town. A gazebo was donated by Arctic Spas and a custom fire pit donated by Westower. All elements needed for the Town's annual Christmas in the Village event. A future sign would recognize large contributors but in October 2019, our planning and fundraising committee was put on hold by the Thorsby Town Council. The Town used the Spirit of Thorsby fundraised money for walkways and a mural but the park was never completed.

In October of 2023, with a new Town Council, the Thorsby & District Chamber of Commerce approached the Town of Thorsby to take over the development and maintenance of Taylor Park. Many of the Chamber volunteer members had already been on the previous Taylor Park Committee. An MOA was signed and so began the Taylor Park development project which was to be fundraised, designed and implemented by the volunteers of the Chamber of Commerce. The Chamber also invited Carol Rempel, now the RMHA Animator, to attend meetings as a non voting member but welcome to give input in the Parks development.

During our planning phase, Matt Ruhr, a director of the Chamber and owner of Ruhr Valley Lumber mentioned he knew someone who welds statues/monuments and may do it for an affordable price because of family

connections. When Matt approached Braden Kiefiuk of Majestic Metal Art to see if he would build us a statue of Thor, he agreed to take on our project and give us the "family price". Our excitement was overwhelming, we were going to have a statue of Thor representing a small part of Thorsby's history.

The next phase was to make Taylor Park a beautiful, comfortable, low maintenance space for our community and the visitors we hoped to attract. With fundraising, donations and many volunteer hours we purchased concrete picnic tables (sponsored by Thorsby Communities in Bloom and Baumann Hoe & Bobcat). We hired a professional landscaper to grade, sod, build a perennial garden and add shrubs. Our volunteers relocated the existing entrance sign for easier access to the park and better visibility and finished all other necessary upgrades and maintenance. Thank you to G&N Contracting for forming and pouring the concrete pads. Thank you as well to Thorsby IDA Royal Care Pharmacy for your support and letting us use your water to water the sod.

Thank you to our active Chamber team and their spouses, Sharon & Darcy Powlik (Darcy Powlik Realty), Matt & Lisa Ruhr (Ruhr Valley Lumber), Carrie & Mike Nelson (Carrie Levins Entertainment), Shawna & Shane Ofstie (CE Media Signs & Promotional) and Jackie & Derryl Knopp (Thorsby Tire). Also to Carol Rempel (RMHA) and Tracy Musson (Town of Thorsby Council Representative). Thank you for all that you have done and continue to do for our group and our community.

Taylor Park and Thor will now be a tourist destination. The goal of our Chamber is to promote our Town and bring visitors to our community ... to shop in our stores, eat in our restaurants and support our local businesses. We also want Thorsby to have something beautiful and iconic that the community can be proud of. Our hope is to inspire and ignite the hearts and minds of our community. In working together, we are building a strong, more engaged community for all...where people want to live, work and play.

Our history books and some online sources say that Thorsby was named after Thor, the God of Thunder. One of the references we found on the website www.canadaehx.com says "Needing a name for the post office, they chose to name it for their home Torsby in Sweden, and choosing to honor the Norse god Thor, gave it the name Thorsby".

The unveiling of our 11 foot statue of Thor is something you don't want to miss. What a fun way to promote our community with our Spirit of Thorsby event with live entertainment, market, dunk tank, wagon rides and so much more. Thor will be revealed at 6pm! On September 7th from 4-8pm, come and see what Thorsby has to offer,

Hopefully everyone enjoyed the long weekend and is looking forward to celebrating Spirit of Thor'sby this upcoming weekend. The library will have a display at the event, and we encourage you to stop in and see what the library has to offer.

It is interesting to learn about the background to the name of our town, dating back to the early 1900's when three Swedish brothers settled in the area and decided to call it Thors Town after their hometown in Sweden. The name relates to "Thor, the God of thunder, war and physical strength. He was known as a friend of all mankind because he kept the giants from destroying the earth". If vou're interested in some local history there are some historical information signs in the Recreation Complex, on the wall from the bowling alley to the library. It's interesting to know that the library was initially started by the Ladies Aid Society and the United Church ladies, and the books were housed in the office of the church. It got its formal start in 1967 as the Thorsby Community Library under Alberta Libraries and was located in the Action Centre, the first school built in Thorsby. It moved to the Recreation complex once it opened in 1981.

Another important initiative that our library has is our "Welcome Baby' bags which are given out to a family when they have their first baby. They are beautiful cloth bags, hand sewn by a library supporter, and include a Canadian board book for the baby, information about the library, good books for babies, rhymes to sing and a free library membership. These are generally given out at the Thorsby Health Unit to first time parents but if you have a child under a year and did not receive a bag, please stop in at the library and inquire about one.



Breton RCMP investigate fatal collision

Wetaskiwin County, Alta. – On August 16, 2024, at approximately 7:17 a.m., Breton RCMP received a report of a serious collision involving a Ford Escape and a Kenworth Construct Dual Tanker south of the intersection of Highway 22 and Township Road 452, south of Alder Flats, Alta.

Breton RCMP attended and Emergency Medical Services and Fire Services were already on scene. The 47-year-old female driver of the Ford Escape was pronounced deceased at the scene. The 15-year-old passenger of the Ford Escape was taken to a local medical facility to be further assessed for injuries. The 82-year-old male driver of the Kenworth truck had minor injuries.

Although the collision is still under investigation, Breton RCMP's preliminary investigation indicates the Ford Escape was heading southbound on Highway 22 when it crossed the centreline and collided with the Kenworth tanker that was headed northbound.

24/7 Steam Blows Notice Genesee Repowering Project

As part of the commissioning process and final testing of Capital Power's Genesee 1&2 Repowering Project there will be periods of unusual noise coming from the site as we complete steam blows for Genesee 1. Steam blows began on August 31 and the noise from the steam blows has been less than anticipated. As of September 3, steam blows will run 24/7 until September 10, which will shorten the overall duration of this process.

Later this fall, we will be completing the same process for Genesee 2 and will share the schedule in advance.

Steam blows are required to clean the steam piping and other steam-related components. The process involves the continuous release of steam through the piping system, which produces noise not normally heard during operation.

We have made efforts to minimize noise and the duration of the steam blows. We recognize the steam blows may inconvenience you and appreciate your patience as we move through this short cycle of the project completion.
