

THOR HAS ARRIVED

On Saturday, September 7, Thorsby's statue of Thor was revealed to the world. Hundreds of people attended the Spirit of Thorsby event hosted by the Thorsby & District Chamber of Commerce to witness the unveiling.

"The goal of our Chamber is to promote our Town and bring visitors to our community, to shop in our stores, eat in our restaurants and support our local businesses. We also want Thorsby to have something beautiful and iconic that the community can be proud of" says Chamber President and business owner Shawna Ofstie.

The Chamber's goal has been achieved even sooner than expected thanks to local celebrity, Chris Scheetz

(formerly of CISN 103.9). Chris, the event MC and loyal supporter of his hometown Thorsby, has some great videos on social media and was interviewed by 630 CHED on Monday morning. News has traveled fast and Thorsby has already had visitors coming from all over to see Thor.

The plaque on Thor explains why the Thorsby & District Chamber of Commerce chose Thor. Among other references, this excerpt quoted from the County of Leduc No. 25 History book published in 1991 was most fitting. "In 1929, when the first train thundered into Thorsby, it would seem appropriate that this tiny settlement was named for the god of thunder. Over two decades before the arrival of the railway, two

brothers, surnamed Salstrom, homesteaded near Weed Creek and operated a frontier post office. The name Thorsby was their choice; when translated from their native Swedish it means Thor's-town."

Thor Sculptor Majestic Metal Art (Braden Kiefiuk) attended the Spirit of Thorsby event to answer questions and participate in the festivities. The details and thought put into this piece is remarkable. Braden also included Norse Symbols on the pedestal base which relate to our great community of Thorsby. 



Need to talk? We can help.

The cost of counselling can be a barrier for many individuals and families. Leduc County's Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) offers access to free counselling sessions to eligible individuals, couples and/or families who are struggling with common, everyday issues.

Counselling subsidy

Short-term preventative counselling supports people who are struggling with common, everyday issues. Some reasons or issues that people seek counselling for include:

- · relationship issues
- communication issues
- marriage preparation
- parenting support
- goal setting or skill building
- mental health issues
- stress

Counselling subsidy eligibility

To qualify for a counselling subsidy, you must:

- be a resident of Leduc County, Calmar, Thorsby or Warburg.
- not have access to an employee or health benefit plan that covers the cost of counselling.
- have a family income of less than \$75,000 per year*.

*If your household income is too high to qualify and you don't have health benefits that cover the cost, there are pay-what-you-can and free options. Contact us for more information.

Eligible households can choose from the following free options:

- Three sessions per individual*
- Six sessions per couple
- Nine sessions per family

*If individuals prefer to attend group sessions with other participants, seven sessions will be allotted.

Sessions must be used within six months or they will expire.

Counselling is provided in partnership with:

- Karunia Counselling
- Family Counselling Centres
- Tansem Psychology
- · Hooves of Hope Ranch
- Tracey Emmel, Counsellor, MScMFT
- · Nurtured Minds Wellness and Therapy Services

Once intake is complete and your subsidy approved, you will be referred to one of the above-listed clinics for counselling services that are available in Leduc, Calmar, Beaumont, Edmonton, Millet and rural locations. Virtual and telephone counselling options are also available.

While offering free counselling sessions reduces the financial burdens for individuals and families, the number of free sessions is quite limited. This counselling subsidy program is meant to provide short-term, skill-based preventative services. We would be happy to refer you to different resources if your needs are more long-term or intensive. We can also support you in creating a financial plan to afford the cost of additional sessions if needed.


A WRONG SIGNAL

As I was driving down the highway, I was about to make a left turn and head south across the highway. There was a truck heading my way, so I patiently waited for him to pass by. When he was a couple of hundred feet in front of me he put on his blinker to indicate that he was turning north on the same road that I was turning south on. Seeing that there was no other vehicle coming behind him, the road was clear for me to safely make my turn, allowing him to make his turn. I paused for a second, and it was this pause that kept me from being broadsided.




