



On September 30, let's recognize, honour and educate



ourselves about Canada's Indigenous people in efforts to understand the historical treatment within the residential school system and the children who survived or never returned home from them.

Orange Shirt Day

Since 2013, Orange Shirt Day - an Indigenous-led initiative - aims to raise awareness of residential school survivors, their families, communities and the intergenerational impacts they had.

The orange shirt symbolizes stripping away the culture. freedom and self-esteem experienced by Indigenous people through the generations. Specifically, in 1973 when six-year-old Phyllis Webstad proudly wore a new orange shirt for her first day of school at St. Joseph Mission Residential School and was stripped of her clothes (and orange shirt) to never wear again.

A Little Bit of History WARBURG MUSEUM

This Warburg Museum is a one-storey, two-room schoolhouse located on in the Village of Warburg. It is significant for its architectural representation of school design in the 1940s, and for its status as a local landmark.

The Warburg Museum is also significant for its association with the institution of Warburg School District #2230. The school district was established as the Sunnybrook School District #2230 on July 9, 1910 and was renamed the Warburg School District #2230 in 1934. The original one-room school was built during the winter of 1912-1913 on SE-1-49-1-W5 at a cost of approximately \$1000. The one-room school was moved to Warburg in 1935, and was later demolished. The existing two-room school was built in 1940 at its current location on SW-35-48-3-W5.

The Warburg Museum has an architectural plan and design representative of county schools built in the 1940s. The symmetrical plan of the building, with a central entrance with one classroom on either side, was typical of the design of 1940s schools.

The Warburg Museum is also significant for its status as a local landmark. The building is located on 50th Street, a main thoroughfare entering Warburg. The building's location and its representative design make it easily recognizable for passing motorists and local residents of Warburg. The building is also familiar to residents of Warburg as many early area residents attended the school as children, prior to the construction of the new, modern school building in 1954. The Warburg School continues to serve Warburg and area as a community museum.

10 Ways to Build Healthy Family Habits

Getting the whole family involved in healthy living is food for everyone-good for parents and grandparents who are active in TOPS, good for teens struggling with their weight and good for preventing obesity in young children. These tips can help you get started.

- Are you getting some amount of activity daily? A quick walk in the morning and a game of tag in the afternoon with your kids counts, too.
- 2. Try to set house rules that encourage healthy behavior. Talk as a family about what the rules should be and set an example.
- 3. Take up exergaming. These are video games that require movement. Many of these games can get your heart pumping and build strength.
- For family night, try something active. Go bowling, take a hike or go to a water park.
- Set a family rule that no one gets more than two hours a day of electronic "screen time." This includes TV, video games, internet and cell phones.
- 6. If you don't have time to go grocery shopping once or twice a week, and fast food keeps finding its way into the house, adjust the family schedule.
- Track your goals. Making a chart with pasteboard and stickers may work well for a family with young children, while teens may prefer to write in a journal.

- 1 1/4 cups chopped onion
- 1 teaspoon dried thyme
- 1½ pounds pumpkin puree
- 1/4 cup praline liqueur
- 7 cups chicken stock
- ½ cup packed brown sugar
- 3/8 cup heavy cream

Directions

- Cook diced sausage in skillet with 2 tablespoons butter for 5 minutes.
- 2. Add onion and cook until soft. Add thyme and pumpkin OR sweet potatoes and cook 5 minutes.
- 3. Add liqueur, broth, and brown sugar. Cover and simmer over low heat for 45 minutes, or until pumpkin OR potatoes are tender.
- 4. In blender puree soup in batches. Return to pan and stir in cream and remaining 2 tablespoons butter. Warm but do not boil. Serve immediately.

Spicy Pumpkin Chili

Ingredients

- 1 pound ground beef
- ½ teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes, or to taste
- · 1 teaspoon minced garlic
- ½ large onion, diced
- 1 green bell pepper, chopped
- 1 red bell pepper, chopped
- 1 (15 ounce) can kidney beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 (15 ounce) can black beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 (15 ounce) can Great Northern beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 (8 ounce) can tomato sauce
- 1 (4 ounce) can tomato sauce with garlic and onions
- 2 (14.5 ounce) cans petite diced tomatoes
- 1 (14.5 ounce) can fire roasted diced tomatoes
- 1 (15 ounce) can pumpkin puree
- · 2 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice
- 2 teaspoons chili powder
- 1 teaspoon ground cumin
- 1 teaspoon salt, or to taste

Directions

- Heat a large skillet over medium-high heat; cook and stir the beef in the skillet until crumbly and no longer pink, about 5 minutes. Stir in the red pepper flakes, garlic, and onion; continue cooking until the beef has browned and the onion has softened and turned translucent. Add the green and red bell pepper and cook 5 minutes more.
- 2. While the beef is cooking, combine the kidney beans,

black beans, Great Northern beans, tomato sauce, tomato sauce with garlic and onions, petite diced tomatoes, fire roasted diced tomatoes, and pumpkin puree in a large slow cooker. Season with pumpkin pie spice, chili powder, cumin, and salt. Stir in the ground beef mixture.

3. Cook on Low until the chili is hot, 1 to 2 hours


Pasta with Sausage and Pumpkin Cream Sauce Ingredients

- 1 (16 ounce) package bow-tie pasta
- 1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 pound bulk sweet Italian sausage
- 1 teaspoon extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 medium onion, finely chopped
- · 4 cloves garlic, chopped
- 1 ½ cups dry white wine
- 1½ tablespoons rubbed sage
- 1 ½ cups chicken stock
- 1 ½ cups canned pumpkin
- 3/4 cup half-and-half
- ½ teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- · salt and ground black pepper to taste

Directions

- 1. Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Cook bow-tie pasta at a boil, stirring occasionally, until tender yet firm to the bite, about 12 minutes.
- Meanwhile, heat 1 tablespoon olive oil in a deep, nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Cook and stir sausage until browned and crumbly, 5 to 7 minutes. Transfer to a paper towel-lined plate. Drain and discard grease.
- 3. Heat teaspoon oil in the skillet. Add onion and garlic; saute until tender, 5 to 8 minutes. Drain pasta and return to the pot.
- 4. Add wine and sage to the skillet. Simmer until wine is reduced by half, about 2 minutes. Pour in chicken stock and pumpkin; stir until sauce starts to bubble. Return sausage to the skillet. Reduce heat and stir in half-and-half. Season sauce with cinnamon, nutmeg, salt, and pepper. Simmer until sauce thickens, 5 to 10 minutes.
- 5. Pour pumpkin cream sauce over the pasta. Toss over low heat for 1 minute. Taste and adjust seasoning.


