

- Remind your kids to look both ways before crossing the street and to use sidewalks whenever possible. If there are no sidewalks, walk facing traffic.







To the Editor:

At a recent Brazeau County council meeting, a number (8) of guidelines were presented to assist in placing members of the public on various boards and committees. Whether these guidelines were applied or how vigorously has to be determined by the public. The other question is Were they applied to council member appointments? If not, why not?

These guidelines are listed below:

- 1. Must be 18 years of age;
- 2. Resident of Brazeau County;
- 3. Good standing with county and currently not involved in legal or complaint with the county;
- 4. Qualified under the regulations of the specific board/committee;
- 5. Education and training applicable to the board/committee;
- 6. Previous board experience and knowledge of Robert's Rules of Order;
- 7. Appointment on other boards/committees
- 8. Divisional representation

Apparently, some members of the public were overlooked because of #3 (conflict with the county). It should be remembered that any perceived conflict would have been created by the council, NOT the public. Lastly, any perceived conflict is with councillors, not the "county" and is completely within the rules of the Municipal Government Act (MGA).

By analogy, council actions remind one of a motorist receiving a speeding ticket while travelling at or below posted speed limit.

With regard to # 5 and 6, will there be a test/evaluation whether appointees are appropriately or sufficiently trained for the job (including councillors)?

With regard to #8, one might note the number of committees that have several people from one side of the river; e.g., with none from the other side.

Lastly, has council done a recent evaluation to determine if any committees no longer serve county purposes and should therefore be removed, as no evidence has ever been provided that some committees justify the expense.


