



Notice of application to be filed for approval of the natural gas distribution franchise agreement between the Town of Thorsby and ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd.

Application summary

The Alberta Utilities Commission expects to receive an application from ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. to approve the existing current and valid natural gas distribution franchise agreement with the Town of Thorsby. This application for approval is required due to changes made by the *Utilities Affordability Statutes Amendment Act, 2024*, to various statutes governing franchise agreements.

The current franchise agreement, which took effect in October of 2021, grants ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. the exclusive right to deliver natural gas to the residents of Town of Thorsby for approximately ten years.

No changes to the franchise agreement or to the franchise fee rate rider percentage are being made as part of this application. The franchise fee rate rider percentage will remain at its current rate, which is 35%. Including linear taxes, the resulting average monthly franchise fee for an average residential customer will remain the same at approximately \$21.54. The franchise fee is calculated based on distribution charges. An average residential customer uses about 105 gigajoules per year.







The Times-Reporter of New Philadelphia, Ohio, reported in September of 1985 that there would be a celebration at the New Orleans municipal swimming pool. The party at the pool was held to celebrate the very first summer that they could remember without anyone drowning at any New Orleans city pool.

In honour of this successful record, 200 people were invited to attend the celebration along with 100 lifeguards from throughout the region. As the party began to conclude and the four lifeguards began to clear the pool, they found a fully dressed body in the deep end.

They frantically tried to revive this 31 year old man, but they were too late. He had drowned in a pool surrounded by 100 certified lifeguards who were celebrating their successful season.

As we look around our area and into our communities, we see people who are drowning in loneliness, hurt and despair. We see those who are less fortunate physically, mentally and spiritually. Perhaps we have been so desensitized that we no longer see them.

If we are to define the word "compassion", we find that it is the feeling for another's sorrows or hardships that lead them to help. This word is from the Latin word "compassio" meaning 'to suffer with'. Feeling sorrow for someone does neither party any good however. Compassion without action is futile.

What a different outlook we would have if we looked for places to serve others. The Bible tells us clearly that Jesus Himself came to serve. He was moved with compassion and healed the sick, opened blind eyes, fed the multitudes, and willingly gave His own life so that you could live. 
