

WARBURG WALL OF FAME INDUCTEE VALERIE FREE

At the Warburg School Awards Ceremony on October 22, Valerie Free (Broadbent) was this year's Warburg Wall of Fame Inductee.

Valerie graduated from Warburg School in 1978 and published the book "*Lighting Up a Hidden World: CFS and Me*" in 2016, advocating for those who are too ill to speak out, educating the public, and offering realistic hope and help for those struggling with chronic fatigue syndrome.

AN ILLNESS DENIED FOR DECADES IS EXPOSED New Book Reveals Surprising Realities of a Hidden Condition

Despite millions of people worldwide who are suffering with chronic fatigue syndrome (CFS) and myalgic encephalomyelitis (ME) - now also known as ME/CFS-doubt remains about the true nature of the illness by those within politics, medicine and

society. The long-term dismissal and disbelief have resulted in devastating consequences: Thousands of people have fallen through the cracks of our health care system - many too ill to fight for their right to appropriate care and medical resources.

"Lighting Up a Hidden World: CFS and ME", a new book by Valerie Free, speaks out for those too ill to do so. It is a call to health care providers, the general public, and anyone who continues to ignore the seriousness and severity of the disease.

In July of 1990, Free came down with a sudden, flu-like illness, and after months of unrelenting and bizarre symptoms, she was diagnosed with CFS. Through years of personal experience and research, she gained the insight and knowledge that has aided her in writing "Lighting Up a Hidden World: CFS and ME".

"Everyone who has read even portions of the book has been interested in the fascinating history and politics of ME and CFS; has been surprised by the facts regarding the lack of research funding; and has been deeply moved by the original poetry and captivating first-hand perspectives from within the ME/CFS community," Free said.

Dr. David Bell, an ME/CFS expert, was one of the first doctors to see a sudden influx of patients in the 1980's who presented with an illness he had never seen before. The illness was later named chronic fatigue syndrome. Dr. Bell wrote: "Valerie Free has managed the nearly impossible. She has brought together descriptions and patient stories that convey what the world has refused to believe - that ME/CFS is not only real, but it is a nightmare that rivals hell itself and continues to be dismissed as a trivial neurosis by educated physicians who should have moved beyond this twenty years ago."

Free also gives resources for the people who live with ME/CFS and other chronic conditions, as well as for those who want to participate in the global search for solutions.

"Lighting Up a Hidden World: CFS and ME" is available for order from Friesen Press Bookstore, Amazon, and most other major online book retailers. The e-book edition will follow shortly for order from GooglePlay and iTunes.

The Alberta Utilities Commission expects to receive an application from ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. to approve the existing current and valid natural gas distribution franchise agreement with the Village of Warburg. This application for approval is required due to changes made by the Utilities Affordability Statutes Amendment Act, 2024, to various statutes governing franchise agreements.

The current franchise agreement, which took effect in November of 2020, grants ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. the exclusive right to deliver natural gas to the residents of Village of Warburg for approximately ten years.

No changes to the franchise agreement or to the franchise fee rate rider percentage are being made as part of this application. The franchise fee rate rider percentage will remain at its current rate, which is 10%. Including linear taxes, the resulting average monthly franchise fee for an average residential customer will remain the same at approximately \$7.51. The franchise fee is calculated based on distribution charges. An average residential customer uses about 105 gigajoules per year.



Gensee Repowering Project Steam Blows

As part of the commissioning process and final testing of Capital Power's Genesee 1&2 Repowering Project there will be periods of unusual noise coming from the site as we complete steam blows for Genesee 2. The steam blows are anticipated to run 24/7 beginning on Wednesday, October 30, and continue for up to two weeks.

Steam blows are required to clean the steam piping and other steam related components. The process involves the continuous release of steam through the piping system, which produces noise not normally heard during operation.


