LEST WE FORGET

In the summer of 2024, the Breton Museum conducted a research project and summer exhibit on the George Grey and Ida Impey family who settled near Breton in 1922. Over the summer several articles on the life and times of the family were written, chronicling their life in Africa and their migration to Canada. The Museum's research revealed the Impey family had a long history of military service. With Remembrance Day on November 11th the Museum thought it fitting to honor the military service of the Impey family.

George Grey Impey had served in both the African Boer War and WWI in South Africa and Kenya. Their four eldest sons: William, Pringle, Alan and James also served during WWI in Africa. Tragically, early in the war, Alan would pay the ultimate sacrifice with his life in British East Africa.

When George G. and Ida moved from Kenya, they were accompanied by their daughters Effie and Enid, and their three youngest sons: George, Hugh and Richard (Dick). Over the next eighteen years the sons and daughters would marry and start families, in addition to establishing farms and businesses in the community.

In 1940, after the declaration of WWII in 1939, all three of their sons enlisted in the Canadian Army. Sons, Hugh and Richard would be deployed to England where they took additional training. Hugh as a light anti aircraft gunner and later as a motorcycle dispatcher. Hugh's son, Tom Impey writes that one of his earliest memories is going with his father, prior to enlisting, to hire a neighbor to assist with the farm work while he was in the Army. Richard was assigned to a motorized unit as a driver and mechanic. They would both see service in: England, France, Belgium and Holland. George enlisted as a gunner in an artillery unit, with his unit remaining in Canada for the duration of the war. All three returned safely home after the war. Richard would return to Vancouver, where he had previously resided. George returned to Breton for a short time, selling his farm on the outskirts of Breton and moving to BC. Hugh returned

to Breton to reunite with his wife Nora and young sons Buddy and Tom, whom he had not seen since 1941.

In addition to their three sons serving with the Canadian Army during WWII, George G. and Ida's eldest grandson, George Frank Impey also enlisted in the Canadian Army. As soon as George turned 18 in 1940, he enlisted. He would be attached to the Seaforth Highlanders serving with the Service Corp. George served in: England, North Africa, Sicily, Italy, France, Belgium, Germany and was in Holland on VE Day. George too returned to Breton after the war to work for the local lumber companies. When the oil boom came, he moved to Edmonton and drove trucks moving oilfield equipment. George retired near Breton and lived the remainder of his life in the Breton/ Winfield area.

Take time on Monday November 11 to attend one of the Remembrance Day Services to remember the sacrifices of our veterans, or just quietly contemplate what our lives might have been like without their service. Thank you for your service.

ACCOUNTABILITY FOR OTTAWA'S CARBON TAX DOUBLE STANDARD

Alberta News, October 29, 2024

Alberta's government has filed an application at the federal court challenging the constitutionality and legality of Canada's heating oil carbon tax exemption.

Alberta's government is standing up against the federal government's carbon tax exemption for heating oil to protect Albertans from the double standard Ottawa has created with the carbon tax, which means Albertans continue to pay carbon taxes to stay warm in winter.

Last fall, after years of insisting that the carbon tax is applied equally across Canada, the federal government exempted the carbon tax for heating oils, which are used predominantly in Atlantic Canada and Quebec. Over the last year, the federal government has refused multiple requests to grant a similar carve-out on other heating methods from Alberta and others across the country who are also facing rising costs of living.

Alberta's government will now take this fight to the courts. Alberta filed an application seeking judicial review of the exemption with the Federal Court on Oct. 29, asking the court to declare that the exemption is both unconstitutional and unlawful. The application argues that Ottawa's carbon tax exemption for heating oil is unconstitutional and inconsistent with the Government of Canada's stated purpose for enacting the Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act.

"Last year, Ottawa decided Canadians in the East deserved a three-year break from paying the carbon tax on their home heating costs. While we're happy for these Canadians, Alberta, Saskatchewan and other provinces who heat their homes with natural gas have been deliberately excluded from these savings. Albertans simply cannot stand by for another winter while the federal government picks and chooses who their carbon tax applies to. Since they won't play fair, we're going to take the federal government back to court." Danielle Smith, Premier

While the Supreme Court of Canada previously found the Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act was constitutional, it found that Canada's jurisdiction to regulate greenhouse gas emissions was limited to the ability to create minimum national standards for carbon pricing for the purpose of reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

Alberta strongly opposes the federal carbon tax exemption on heating oil, as the federal government is

no longer creating minimum national standards that apply evenly across the country, and is instead creating a regime that favours one region and fuel type over others.

"This exemption is not only unfair to the vast majority of Canadians, but it is also unlawful as the federal government does not have the authority to make special exemptions for certain parts of the country under the Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act. The federal government isn't even following its own laws now. Someone needs to hold them accountable, and Alberta is stepping up to do just that." Mickey Amery, Minister of Justice and Attorney General

The federal carbon tax adds to the rising cost of living for all Canadians. By 2030, it will cost Canadians \$25 billion every year, in addition to lowering the gross domestic product (GDP) by \$9 billion. In addition, the Bank of Canada has estimated that the federal carbon tax increases inflation by 0.15 per cent year over year.

 - Less than one per cent in Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba

CONNECT CARE IN MORE SITES, PROGRAMS IN ALBERTA

November 2, 2024, AHS News

Alberta Health Services (AHS) today completed the ninth and final launch of Connect Care, bringing more than 11,000 additional staff and physicians at 155 AHS and AHS-partner sites and locations, onto the common provincial information system.

AHS has led the way in Canada with Connect Care as the only health authority in the country with a provincewide clinical information system. In addition to this, AHS has the lowest cost per user to operate the system when compared to other clients of the software vendor, Epic Systems, who are of a similar scale to AHS. Connect Care gives healthcare providers more tools to support their patients at almost half the cost per user of the systems AHS had previously in place. It also supports the desire of Albertans to have access to their health information.

With Launch 9, Connect Care is in place across all AHS and AHS partner programs, services and sites in Alberta. This launch includes:

- Community Care and Home Care programs and services in Edmonton, North, Calgary, Central and South zones.
- Population Public Health sites across Calgary, Edmonton, Central and North zones.
- Health Link's 13 provincial programs.
- Community ambulatory clinics in North, Edmonton, Calgary and South zones, and Bone and Joint clinics in Calgary, Central and Edmonton zones.
- Recovery Alberta's 10 Correctional Health Services facilities across all five zones.
- 12 CapitalCare facilities and five Covenant Health sites in the Edmonton Zone.

The initiative supports best practices across AHS, and enables health records from AHS, and its subsidiaries and partners to be accessed through one system. It also provides clinicians with common decision-making support. Through Alberta's MyHealth Records, Albertans have access to MyAHS Connect, an online patient portal where people can see their health information, test results and medications; manage appointments; and communicate securely with their AHS healthcare team.

With Launch 9, there are now more than 125,000 staff, physicians and other healthcare providers using Connect Care to improve care for patients, in more than 1,000 sites and programs across all five AHS zones.

"Today marks an impressive milestone for AHS," says AHS President and CEO Athana Mentzelopoulos.

"Health information across all AHS programs and services and with our partners is now integrated, so front-line healthcare workers, physicians and patients have shared information that gives the whole healthcare team a more complete health history for patients, access to consistent information on best practices and resources at their fingertips, while improving our ability to keep information private and secure."

The switch over to Connect Care went as planned as teams at these locations transitioned to the new information system at 5 a.m. today.


"This launch marks the ninth rollout of Connect Care over five years. It has been an incredible effort that helps AHS physicians and other healthcare providers do their best possible work."

By having a common clinical information system, care teams across AHS and our partners have access to a patient's complex histories and medication lists, with information that travels with the patient wherever Connect Care is in place," says Dr. Peter Jamieson, Vice President, Quality, and Chief Medical Officer. "It has improved how we care for patients and clients across the province."

All launches to date have included plans to ensure care is not compromised during the transition. Patients may see care teams taking a little extra time to complete their charting and other tasks during launch as they adjust to these improvements.

"The scale of Connect Care makes it one of the largest clinical system implementations in the world," adds Sean Chilton, AHS Interim Vice President and Chief Operating Officer, Clinical Operations and EMS.

"Right from the onset of planning over a decade ago, patients, physicians, nurses, midwives, other front-line staff, technical teams, and patient and family advisors have been instrumental in designing the clinical information system for Connect Care. We could not have gotten to this final launch without their support and input every step of the way."

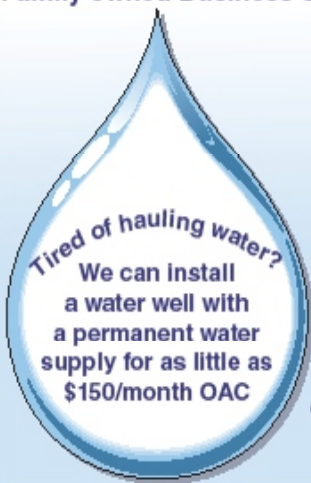

COUNTY OF WETASKIWIN DRAFT LAND USE BYLAW NOW AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC REVIEW

County of Wetaskiwin News Release October 24, 2024

The County of Wetaskiwin is pleased to announce that the draft of the new Land Use Bylaw (LUB) is now available for public review and feedback. The Land Use Bylaw is the regulatory framework that guides how land is developed and used within the County, ensuring sustainable growth and protecting community values.

Over the past year, the County has gathered input through surveys, workshops, and open houses to understand community needs and potential changes to the Land Use Bylaw. Feedback has been summarized in the "What We Heard Report," available on the County's Land Use Bylaw Review Webpage.

"Our biggest project this year has been the update to our Land Use Bylaw," said Reeve Josh Bishop. "We toured the County and held open houses to gather your feedback, which has played a key role in shaping the draft Bylaw. The draft is now available for review on our website. This is your chance to let us know if we have struck the right balance. We have worked to simplify regulations while protecting the rights and quality of life for everyone in our community."

Key Proposed Changes:

- District Simplification: Reducing the number of land use districts from over 30 to 10.
- Additional Dwelling Units: Allowing up to 2 dwellings per lot.
- Recreational Units (Rus): Streamlining regulations for storage and use on private property.
- Home-Based Businesses: Reducing the number of categories and easing permit requirements for minor home occupations.
- Clearer Decision Criteria: Adding evaluation guidelines for discretionary uses and variances.

Next Steps

Initial public input on the draft Land Use Bylaw will be accepted until **November 13, 2024**. The feedback will be reviewed by the Project Team and any recommended changes will be presented to Council at their meeting on **November 26, 2024**. At this Meeting, Council will also consider setting a date for a Public Hearing, tentatively scheduled for **December 17, 2024**.

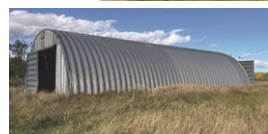

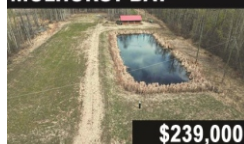
