BIG WIN FOR ALBERTA AND CANADA

Alberta News, April 2, 2025

Premier Danielle Smith issued the following statement on the April 2, 2025 U.S. tariff announcement:

"Today was an important win for Canada and Alberta, as it appears the United States has decided to uphold the majority of the free trade agreement (CUSMA) between our two nations. It also appears this will continue to be the case until after the Canadian federal election has concluded and the newly elected Canadian government is able to renegotiate CUSMA with the U.S. administration.

"This is precisely what I have been advocating for from the U.S. administration for months.

"It means that the majority of goods sold into the United States from Canada will have no tariffs applied to them, including zero per cent tariffs on energy, minerals, agricultural products, uranium, seafood, potash and host of other Canadian goods.

"There is still work to be done, of course. Unfortunately, tariffs previously announced by the United States on Canadian automobiles, steel and aluminum have not been removed. The efforts of premiers and the federal government should therefore shift towards removing or significantly reducing these remaining tariffs as we go forward and ensuring affected workers across Canada are generously supported until the situation is resolved.

"I again call on all involved in our national advocacy efforts to focus on diplomacy and persuasion while avoiding unnecessary escalation. Clearly, this strategy has been the most effective to this point.

"As it appears the worst of this tariff dispute is behind us (though there is still work to be done), it is my sincere hope that we, as Canadians, can abandon the disastrous policies that have made Canada vulnerable to and overly dependent on the United States, fast-track national resource corridors, get out of the way of provincial resource development and turn our country into an independent economic juggernaut and energy superpower."

Community Volunteer Income Tax Program - FREE INCOME TAX PREPARATION - For low income persons, families, seniors and students. Although this is something that most of us would like to avoid thinking about and doing, I am afraid that this is unavoidable. You need to file your income tax each year, even if you have no income to report. By doing this you may receive benefits that you did not know you were eligible for. Also, in the event of the death of your spouse, benefits can easily be transferred to you, if you have filled a return for the last calendar year. If you did not file a tax return in 2024 you may not be receiving benefits from the government that you are eligible for. The focus of the Community Volunteer Tax Program is to assist those individuals who have limited income. This includes seniors, families, and students. If your income was approximately in one of the following categories, you may qualify for assistance.

*1 person - \$35,000/*Couple \$45,000/*Family - \$52,500 We are not able to complete returns with income from the following sources: Capital Gains or Losses, Farming Income, Rental Income, Self-Employment, Interest exceeding \$1,000, Bankruptcies, Deceased Persons

This service is FREE to those who qualify. If you require this service, please gather your information, and bring it to the Village of Breton office Monday to Thursday between 8:30am-4pm.

Clients will be notified when your return is completed. The program will run from March 3 – April 30, 2025.

#1 IN CANADA

Alberta News, April 3, 2025

This year Albertans recycled billions of cans and bottles, earning the #1 spot in Canada and #2 in North America.

After narrowly being beaten out by Prince Edward Island in 2022, Alberta is back on top, regaining the highest beverage container return rate in all of Canada. In 2024, Albertans returned more than two billion cans, bottles and other containers, or 85 per cent of all non-refillable beverage containers. The national average was a paltry 76 per cent. Runners-up include Saskatchewan at 84 per cent, British Columbia at 83 per cent, Ontario at 75 per cent and Quebec at 68 per cent.

Alberta also continues to rapidly gain in the North American rankings, going from ninth in 2016 to fourth in 2018, to second place in 2022 and 2024, trailing only the state of Oregon. Although Oregon took the top spot, the U.S. state only returns plastic, metal and glass beverage containers. Albertans return a much wider range of beverage containers, including plastic, metal, glass, aseptic carton packages like juice boxes, bag-in-a-box containers like boxed wine, gable tops like milk paperboard cartons, and pouches like those used for juice.

"Albertans are winners and these results prove it. My call to Albertans is simple: when you are finished with your cans and bottles, recycle. Put money back in your pocket. And keep helping your fellow Albertans beat the competition." Rebecca Schulz, Minister of Environment and Protected Areas

"Alberta's ranking as the top jurisdiction in Canada and second in North America for beverage container recycling demonstrates the effectiveness of our regulatory framework and the collaboration of all system partners. The Beverage Container Management Board is proud to oversee a system that delivers strong environmental outcomes while maintaining accountability and efficiency. This success is a direct result of our shared commitment to continuous improvement and innovation in beverage container recycling." "Bottle depots are the frontline and backbone of Alberta's recycling success, providing convenient, accessible and community-focused beverage container collection services. This recognition is a testament to the hard work and dedication of Alberta's 219 depot operators, collaboration amongst industry partners, and a regulatory framework that encourages depots to invest in great customer experiences and Albertans to return their beverage containers." Quick facts:

- Alberta recycles more than 150,000 different types of non-refillable beverage containers sold in the province.
- Alberta has 219 depots that provide a refund in exchange for the return of used, empty beverage containers. After sorting, counting and providing a refund, Depots ship the used beverage containers to be recycled.
- In the most recent Global Deposit Book, Alberta's return rate was the highest reported in Canada and trailed only Oregon's 87 per cent among measured jurisdictions in North America.



NURSING NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE

Alberta News, April 3, 2025

President of Treasury Board and Minister of Finance Nate Horner issued the following statement on ratification of a new contract between Alberta Health Services and the United Nurses of Alberta.

"We all have tremendous respect for nurses and know that our health care system could not thrive without them.

"This new agreement places Alberta's registered nurses in a strong and competitive position in the marketplace, which will support recruitment and retention.

"In addition, the Graduate Nursing Transition Pilot Program commits to hiring 1,000 new nursing graduates every year, throughout the term of the contract. This means that almost every nurse who graduates from a post-secondary institution in the province could have a full-time position following graduation.

"All of these initiatives will hopefully reduce the need for overtime, agency staffing and the need to recruit internationally educated nurses.

"Investment into recruitment for rural and remote areas will triple, to more than \$22 million per year, attracting nurses in all communities. Both parties agreed to address safe staffing processes, which are now contained in the agreement.

"My thanks to the union leadership and Alberta Health Services for reaching a fair and equitable settlement that balances government's ability to continue to invest in health care and provide fair and market-based compensation for nurses."

April 1, 2025 - Regular Council Meeting

Financial Audit Report

Phil Dirks of Metrix Group LLP presented the results of the 2024 Financial Audit. He confirmed that the County is in good financial shape.

The County has \$56.4 million in assets, \$13.4 million in liabilities, including \$5.7 million in debt, and a remaining debt capacity of \$43.7 million.

By law, all municipalities must be audited each year. The approved financial statements will be posted to the County website shortly.

Alberta Energy Regulators

Shaunna Cartwright, Director, Minerals Strategy and Implementation, Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) and Kelsey MacCormack, Director, Geology and Resources, Alberta Geological Survey presented the AER's expanded mandate including regulations around Alberta's helium, geothermal energy and minerals.

100-Year Farm Family Policy

Council rescinded the AG-27 100-Year Farm Award Policy. The County will instead advocate and celebrate the Alberta Century Farm and Ranch Award and support local producers in receiving provincial recognition.

November 18 Council Meeting

Council cancelled the November 18, 2025 Council meeting, as it interferes with the Rural Municipalities of Alberta (RMA) fall convention.





The Ministry of Agriculture and Irrigation is committed to working with its national and international counterparts to advance shared interests and maximize efficiencies in the North American agri-food industry that can lead to mutually beneficial opportunities for producers, processors and consumers.

Minister Sigurdson will travel with one staff member. Mission expenses will be posted on the travel and expense disclosure page.

Quick facts:

- The U.S. remains Canada's and Alberta's most valuable export market for agricultural products, including live cattle, beef, canola seed, meal and oil, and processed potatoes.
- In 2024, these top five exports to the U.S. totaled \$7 billion, a 5.7 per cent increase over 2023.
- Canada is the most important market for many states. importing US\$28.1 billion (C\$38.5 billion) of agriculture and food products in 2024.
- · Alberta imports from the U.S. include fruits and vegetables, food products, live cattle and beverages.
- U.S. demand for beef is strong with consumers eating about 60 pounds per capita in 2024.
- In 2024, Alberta exported more than 400,000 head of live cattle to the U.S. and almost 90 per cent were for immediate slaughter.




During my job interview yesterday, the interviewer asked, 'Why do you think I should give you this job?'
