FEDERAL GENERAL ELECTION 2025

If you haven't already voted in the advanced polls, make sure to cast your vote on April 28 from 7:30am - 7:30pm at the voting station listed on your voter registration card.

Did you know? Several ridings had their boundaries shifted and new districts were created out of the 2022 federal electoral district redistribution effort. There are now 37 electoral districts in Alberta. There were 34 districts in the last federal election in 2021. Here are two of the new electoral districts and their candidates.

Parkland District

The newly formed Parkland district, sits west of Edmonton and includes all of Parkland County, the eastern portion of Yellowhead County and a part of Lac Ste. Anne County.

Dane Lloyd is the incumbent Conservative MP for the former St. Albert-Sturgeon River riding and is running in the new electoral district. Lloyd is a three-time incumbent in the St. Albert-Sturgeon River riding and first won the seat in a 2017 by-election to replace Rona Ambrose.

Leduc Wetaskiwin District


The newly formed Leduc-Wetaskiwin district uses the rural portion of the former Edmonton-Wetaskiwin riding, and includes all of Leduc County and the First Nations between Wetaskiwin and Ponoka.

Mike Lake is the incumbent Conservative MP for Edmonton-Wetaskiwin who won the riding in landslides the last three elections. Before 2015, Lake represented


the former Edmonton—Mill Woods—Beaumont riding for nine years as a Conservative.

Although this is something that most of us would like to avoid thinking about and doing, I am afraid that this is unavoidable. You need to file your income tax each year, even if you have no income to report. By doing this you may receive benefits that you did not know you were eligible for. Also, in the event of the death of your spouse, benefits can easily be transferred to you, if you have filled a return for the last calendar year. If you did not file a tax return in 2024 you may not be receiving benefits from the government that you are eligible for. The focus of the Community Volunteer Tax Program is to assist those individuals who have limited income. This includes seniors, families, and students. If your income was approximately in one of the following categories, you may qualify for assistance.

*1 person - \$35,000/*Couple \$45,000/*Family - \$52,500 We are not able to complete returns with income from the following sources: Capital Gains or Losses, Farming Income, Rental Income, Self-Employment, Interest exceeding \$1,000, Bankruptcies, Deceased Persons

This service is FREE to those who qualify. If you require this service, please gather your information, and bring it to the Village of Breton office Monday to Thursday between 8:30am-4pm.

Clients will be notified when your return is completed. The program will run from March 3 – April 30, 2025.

We require the following information to complete your return:

- Personal Information (Social Insurance Number, Birth date, Marital Status, Address)
- Dependent's information spouse/ children's names, birthdates.
- All "T" Slips (T4's, T4A, OAS etc.)
- All Forms, Schedules, and Labels you have received from Revenue Canada.
- Receipts for any expenses such as medical, moving, tuition, sporting activities. Printouts from your pharmacist are available for those with numerous prescriptions.




And now we are content that our life was worthwhile. Knowing, as we passed along the way, we made somebody smile.

BRAZEAU COUNTY PASSES 2025 FINAL BUDGET

Brazeau County, April 15, 2025

On April 7th, Brazeau County Council passed the final budget for 2025, with a focus on core services.

The budget maintains the years-long freeze on municipal taxes. Fees, which were limited to zero or to minimal levels in previous years, are not set to increase.

The budget also includes \$11.9 million in capital investment in roads, equipment replacement, and other infrastructure, and accounts for a 30% incentive on residential taxes that are paid on by June 30th. It also maintains the 25% mill rate decrease from last year in municipal taxes for properties for the small business sub-class.

"Low taxes, low fees, and smart investments in infrastructure remain our top priorities," says Reeve Bart Guyon. "We have a balanced budget that ensures money stays in ratepayers' pockets while focusing on essential capital projects."

Infrastructure investments and other initiatives include:

- An additional Community Peace Officer position
- A joint 10-Year ALUS anniversary and an ASB producer appreciation dinner
- Five microsurfacing road maintenance projects
- Base stabilization and cape sealing of internal roads at Northside Acres and Fairway Meadows
- Replacement of fencing and new sorting equipment at the Lindale Rodeo Grounds
- Replacement of Drayton Valley/Brazeau County Fire Services aerial truck
- Investment in efficiency upgrades at the Cynthia solar aquatics plant
- Equipment replacement
- A joint 10-Year ALUS anniversary and an ASB producer appreciation dinner

Residents are reminded that the province has increased the amount Brazeau County will collect for the education tax. The County only collects this tax and passes it on the province, and has no say in setting the education tax rate.


RESIGNATION OF DIVISION 3 COUNCILLOR CODY BROOKS





Tax Rate Bylaw

Council adopted Tax Rate Bylaw 1206-25, which continues to carry forward a 30% reduction in the residential and farmland tax rate directed by Council in 2015, as well as a 25% reduction in the tax rate for small business and vacant non-residential properties (that meet the eligibility criteria) passed in 2023. Taxes must be paid before June 30 to receive the incentive.

Support for Equine Therapy

Council provided \$3,440 to support the Wildrose School Division in offering an equine therapy program to six students. Equine therapy has been widely recognized for its ability to support students' emotional, social, and mental well-being.






