Seniors Assisted Transportation Subsidy

Eligibility

- Have sufficient mobility to enter and exit vehicles independently

Number of rides

- Seniors 65 years to 79 years are eligible for five free round trips for medical appointments.
- Seniors 80 years and older are eligible for 10 free round trips for medical, recreational, social or supportive needs.

Memberships

All program participants are required to purchase a Drive Happiness annual membership. Membership fees are determined by Drive Happiness and are based on household income.






Our members made the difficult decision to go on strike because our wages have not kept up with inflation. For the vast majority of our members, our wages could not cover essentials, like food and housing. We also felt that with lower wages compared to neighbouring school boards, the school division was unable to recruit and retain quality support staff.

Because of the resolve of our members and support from our student and parent community, our strike was successful. Our members will see a more meaningful wage increase over four years. Black Gold agreed to a market adjustment above a general wage increase for the vast majority of our members that raised wages so that they would be more comparable to neighbouring school divisions. It is our hope that this will allow Black Gold to attract and retain quality staff that make a positive impact on the education our students receive.

We also want to thank Black Gold School Division for their commitment to negotiations during the strike. They listened to our concerns and worked to reach a settlement that is good for support staff and students. We look forward to working with the school division to continue to build quality, public education for students across Black Gold.













MORE WATER AVAILABLE

Alberta News, April 4, 2025

Alberta is making more water available for communities, businesses and irrigators by removing the 10 per cent holdback on most water licence transfers.

Alberta's communities and economy are growing fast, and so does the demand for water. Traditionally, water transfers required 10 percent of the water be held back, often preventing readily available water from being safely used by irrigators, businesses and communities that need it.

Alberta's government has released three new policy directions so that water is only held back when absolutely needed. These new rules will make water transfers easier, free up more water in southern and central Alberta, and support economic growth for agriculture, industry and municipalities.

"Alberta communities, irrigators, and industry have asked for a more flexible system. Removing unnecessary holdbacks will make it easier – and less costly – for water license users to get the water they need, when they need it most, without reducing their overall allocation." Rebecca Schulz, Minister of Environment and Protected Areas

Previously, 10 per cent holdbacks were taken for most licence transfers. Alberta's government recently engaged with water users across the province and heard repeatedly that unnecessary holdbacks are reducing water-sharing, adding unnecessary costs and limiting the potential water supply during droughts and shortages. For example, under the previous system, a southern Alberta irrigator transferring water to another farmer would have had to hold back 10 per cent of that amount, often meaning that thousands of cubic meters of water cannot go to where they are desperately needed.

Now, water will only be held back as needed to prevent negatively affecting other water users or the environment, in line with the requirements under the Water Act. In Alberta, water licences are already issued with specific conditions designed to protect the aquatic environment, meaning most additional holdbacks are not needed. This change will also make the system more effective as water licence holders can now transfer unused water to others who need it.

The new guidance applies to all river basins where transfers are allowed, including the South Saskatchewan River, Battle River and Milk River. The new policy guidance will make sure that future decisions on transfer applications follow a consistent and common-sense approach across regions for determining if holdbacks are needed.

This is part of the province's ongoing work to maximize water availability in Alberta. The government engaged with Albertans in late 2024 and early 2025 to hear ideas about how to strengthen and modernize the water system. This is complex and nuanced work and government is working to identify which gaps and opportunities can be addressed in 2025, and which will require further engagement with Albertans to explore options and plans for implementation.

Quick Facts

- There are about 25,000 water licences in Alberta.
- The *Water Act* enables licences to be transferred, in whole or in part, in areas where an approved water management plan is established. Approved plans are in place in the Milk, South Saskatchewan and Battle River basins.
- As of January 2025, there have been 407 completed water transfers, most of which occurred in the South Saskatchewan River Basin and some in the Battle River basin.
 - Holdbacks were taken in 256 of 407 completed transfers.

2025 Dust Control Program

Application deadline: Thursday, May 15

Leduc County is currently accepting applications for our 2025 dust control program. There are two product choices available:

1. Calcium chloride

Calcium chloride is a top shoot dust control product that is applied by spraying over the gravel surface.

- Two applications of product will be completed for every residence applying for this dust control product. The second application will be automatically applied approximately six-to-eight weeks after the first application (weather permitting).
- Residents desiring a calcium chloride dust control product on the County road adjacent to their residence will be required to complete an application form and must prepay a fee of **\$640.45** for the first 122 metres (400 feet). Dust control requested beyond 122 metres (400 feet) will be charged an additional **\$10.50/metre**.

2. Incorporated petroleum

Incorporated dust control is a petroleum-based product that is applied to the road surface and mixed in and packed by graders.

- It is warrantied for one year from the date of application.
- Residents desiring an incorporated dust control product on the County road adjacent to their residence will be required to complete an application form and must prepay a fee of **\$4,359.55** for the first 122 metres (400 feet). Dust control beyond 122 metres (400 feet) will be charged an additional **\$40.98/metre**.

Other information

- GST will be added to all prices listed above.
- The prices listed are after receiving a Leduc County subsidy of **\$640.45** per strip.
- This subsidy is provided to County residents living in permanent residences along a county gravel road.
- Businesses will be charged the full rate without subsidy.
- The dust control program begins as soon as possible after seasonal road bans have been lifted.

MODERNIZING MUNICIPAL PROCESSES

Alberta News, April 8, 2025

Proposed amendments will strengthen local governance and collaboration, streamline processes and bolster protections for new home builders and buyers.

Alberta's government is committed to ensuring Albertans' local governments are strong and collaborative and that their investments in new homes are protected. That is why Alberta's government is proposing amendments through the *Municipal Affairs Statutes Amendment Act, 2025* to modernize and streamline municipal processes in the *Local Authorities Election Act,* the *Municipal Government Act,* and the *New Home Buyer Protection Act.* These amendments build upon previous legislative changes.

"We're proposing updates to legislation to ensure that Albertans' local governments deliver them the best results by working collaboratively, and that their investments in new homes are protected. Our proposed amendments are based off consultations with industry and municipal partners and will help our government deliver just that for Albertans." Ric McIver, Minister of Municipal Affairs

Aligning municipal campaign finance rules and enhancing voter accessibility

Proposed changes to the *Local Authorities Election Act* (*LAEA*) would improve fairness and transparency in local elections – especially in Calgary and Edmonton – by allowing campaign funds to be shared between local political parties and their candidates, just like at the provincial level. Parties would also be required to disclose their financial records ahead of the October 2025 municipal elections, giving voters better insight into campaign financing.

Other *LAEA* amendments are specific to the Municipality of Jasper, where Alberta's government remains committed to supporting residents as they recover from last year's wildfires. As part of this work, proposed amendments will allow residents who remain temporarily displaced to vote and run in the upcoming local elections, provided they intend to return to the community.

To preserve the voting rights of Albertans who live with disabilities, proposed amendments would also enable municipalities to use elector assistance terminals for the upcoming fall 2025 local elections. Elector assistance terminals do not count ballots, are not connected to a vote-counting network and do not replace paper ballots.

This amendment will ensure that all Albertans who are blind, Deafblind, or have low vision will have equal opportunity to vote secretly and with dignity in upcoming municipal elections." Eliminating Council Codes of Conduct

In recent years, municipal codes of conduct have been weaponized between elected members of some local councils in Alberta, resulting in mistrust, dysfunction and failure to serve Albertans. Proposed amendments would repeal the requirement for municipal councils to have a formal code of conduct and prevent them from implementing their own locally developed codes of conduct.

This will help ensure council members are held accountable at the polls, every four years, by the voters who initially elected them. They may also be recalled by a petition of electors. If the bill passes, Alberta's government will engage with municipalities on the establishment of common practices for municipal councils and an independent ethics commissioner to address ethics matters involving municipal council members.

Updating Intermunicipal Collaboration Frameworks

Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework (ICF) agreements foster collaboration between municipal neighbours to improve the delivery of intermunicipal services for Albertans, but some municipalities have expressed concern that some of the rules around ICFs create confusion and unnecessary red tape. Proposed amendments, based on feedback and engagement with municipal partners, would address these concerns by specifying which intermunicipal services must be included in an ICF, and strengthen the dispute resolution process to ensure ICFs are adopted and implemented effectively.

Strengthening protections for new home builders and buyers

If passed, the *Municipal Affairs Statutes Amendment Act, 2025* would also help safeguard the investments of hard-working Albertans by enhancing protections that ensure homes are built to meet construction safety and quality standards. Proposed amendments would streamline owner-builder applications, offer greater flexibility in warranty exemptions and enable the creation of an advisory group for homebuyer protections. This approach will strengthen consumer protection and

improve affordability by making existing programs more effective, efficient and user-friendly while providing a safety net that helps protect all parties in the event of construction defects.

Future changes to regulations will also introduce builder competencies and establish a robust system to resolve disputes.

The proposed changes will help ensure homes continue to be built to high safety and quality standards, while supporting increasingly efficient systems and procedures for administering new home warranty." - The *Local Authorities Election Act* establishes the framework for the conduct of elections in Alberta municipalities, school divisions, irrigation districts and Metis Settlements.
- The *Municipal Government Act* establishes the rules governing the conduct of local elected officials once on council, as well as the overall administration and operation of municipal authorities in Alberta, including any policy those authorities may wish to implement.
- The *New Home Buyer Protection Act* makes home warranty coverage mandatory for new homes in Alberta.
 - This legislation applies to single-family homes, multi-family homes, duplexes, condominiums, manufactured homes and recreational properties constructed under a building permit applied for on or after February 1, 2014.
