Thorsby - St Matthews' New Glass Cross

Background Story

The idea of a lasting memento to mark the 90th Anniversary of St Matthew's Lutheran Church, Thorsby, was sparked during a conversation between two friends with strong links to the Church. Joan Straathof is an active member of the church and Chandell Popik is a local artist with lifelong links to St Matthew's going back over 50 years when she was baptised in the church. In their conversation, the concept of a multi- coloured glass cross on a bright wall above the altar at the front of the church gradually crystallised. A proposal was taken to Church Council and following formal approval at a meeting of church Membership the St Matthew's Glass Cross project was launched.

Unveiling of the Cross

Last Sunday during the Easter Sunday Service the new Cross was unveiled and dedicated by Pastor Rick Chappell. During the service Joan Straathof read a letter of congratulations from Bishop Trish Schermund (Bishop of Alberta and Territories).

The Bishop congratulated the artist and ended her letter with these words. *"For every eye that beholds may it be a proclamation of love. For every broken spirit may it be a sign of healing. For all who worship a reminder of God's incredible story with us."*

No photograph could possibly do justice to the striking appearance of the Cross. The flow of the changing colours matched by the sparkling and glistening flashes of white, as it is viewed from different angles, makes it come alive.

The artist Chandell Popick assured us that :

"The colours in the glass will never fade or peel away; they are crafted from a blend of minerals and chemicals mixed and blown into the glass at around 2400°C. I assure you; the richness of these colours will endure for centuries and beyond."



Comments by the Artist

"The installation of this cross took longer than I anticipated, and I couldn't have completed it without the love, support and installation help and expertise of my boyfriend, Ken; the wisdom and guidance of my father; and the unwavering encouragement from my daughter, my grandson Owen, my sister, and my parents. I have always been the kid pushing the boundaries of my universe, and this project is no exception. It may not be the largest I've created, but it is certainly the heaviest and most challenging installation to date.

Thank you for trusting me to design and build this glass art piece for the church. May it bring renewed energy, growth, and a constant flow of love, light, and joy to all who worship and visit St. Matthew's Lutheran Church."

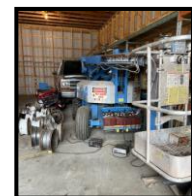

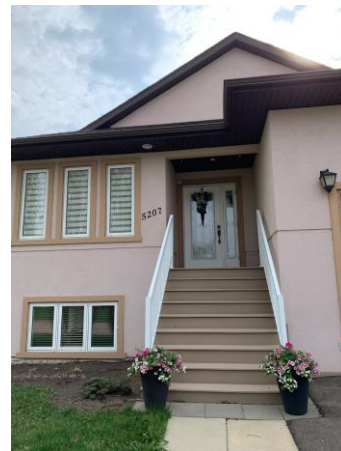

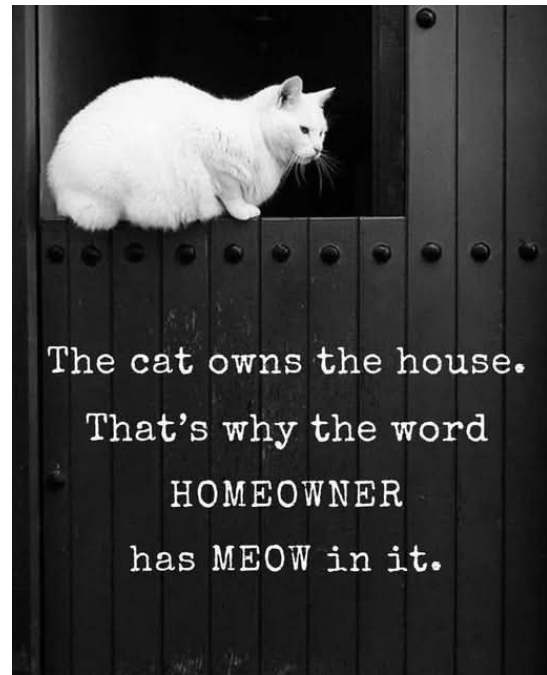

2025 Dust Control Program

Application deadline: Thursday, May 15

Leduc County is currently accepting applications for our 2025
dust control program. There are two product choices available:

1. Calcium chloride

Calcium chloride is a top shoot dust control product that is
applied by spraying over the gravel surface.

- Two applications of product will be completed for every
residence applying for this dust control product. The
second application will be automatically applied
approximately six-to-eight weeks after the first application
(weather permitting).
- Residents desiring a calcium chloride dust control product
on the County road adjacent to their residence will be
required to complete an application form and must prepay
a fee of **\$640.45** for the first 122 metres (400 feet). Dust
control requested beyond 122 metres (400 feet) will be
charged an additional **\$10.50/metre**.

2. Incorporated petroleum

Incorporated dust control is a petroleum-based product that
is applied to the road surface and mixed in and packed by
graders.

- It is warranted for one year from the date of
application.
- Residents desiring an incorporated dust control
product on the County road adjacent to their
residence will be required to complete an application form
and must prepay a fee of **\$4,359.55** for the first 122
metres (400 feet). Dust control beyond 122 metres (400
feet) will be charged an additional **\$40.98/metre**.

Other information

- GST will be added to all prices listed above.
- The prices listed are after receiving a Leduc County
subsidy of **\$640.45** per strip.
- This subsidy is provided to County residents living in
permanent residences along a county gravel road.
- Businesses will be charged the full rate without
subsidy.
- The dust control program begins as soon as
possible after seasonal road bans have been lifted.

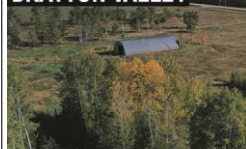
