D-Stress: Stress Management in Challenging Times


D-Stress is an interactive workshop that focuses on stress and how we can recognize when it becomes a problem for our health.

With love and laughter through our tears, we announce the peaceful passing of Clarence Huff at age 93. A lifelong farmer, mischief-maker, and family man, Clarence lived simply but left a lasting impact on everyone who knew him.

Born to William and Elsie Huff as the youngest of 4 children, Clarence married the love of his life, Esther, in 1955. Together they built their own home, raised four children, farmed side by side and lived a life rooted in love, hard work, family, and community.

Clarence was happiest outdoors—skidooing, ice fishing, mowing grass, or helping (and sometimes hindering) Esther in her garden. He was known for always having cheese and pickles on hand, serving up orange floats in the afternoon, being a ruthless card player, and showing his grandkids how to get into just enough good trouble to keep life interesting.

After Esther's passing in 2007, he carried her memory with him every day, telling us in his final days how much he looked forward to seeing her again. He is survived by his children Beverly Olsen (Terry), Brenda Belozzer (Glenn), Laurie Mayr (Dwayne), and Garry Huff (Nicky) and 16 cherished grandkids, and 21 great grandkids who will carry forward his legacy to live simply surrounded by family, love, and laughter.

A private family gathering will be held. In his honor; play a game of crib, sneak a snack, visit a neighbor; or sit outside and listen to the birds—Clarence wouldn't want a fuss, just a good story and a bit of fun.







Focus on Fitness

Get Moving - 8 ways Exercises improve your Health

1. Exercise is an appetite suppressant, sometimes delaying the return of hunger for hours
2. Exercise triggers the release in the brain of natural tranquilizing chemicals called endorphins, resulting in the relief of tension or depression that may prompt you to overeat
3. Exercise builds up muscle tissue, which burns calories at a higher rate than body fat. This makes it possible to eat more without gaining or to lose more rapidly without changing caloric intake.
4. Because muscle tissue takes up less space than the same weight of fat, active people look thinner than their sedentary counterparts who weigh the same.
5. For up to 14 hours after exercise, the body continues to burn calories at a higher rate than it would have without exercise. In other words, exercise raises the body's idling speed for hours after exercise is over.
6. Fat is lost from the body almost exclusively by being burned in muscles. The only way you are ever going to lose fat is if your muscles burn it as fuel. In other words, you need to exercise!
7. Consistent exercise reduces body fat, lowers blood concentration of cholesterol and triglycerides, increases levels of high-density lipoprotein(HDL) cholesterol, and may reduce high blood pressure and lower blood sugar levels.
8. Remember the 2 A's- accessible, available! Make sure the fitness program you choose is practical and convenient. Do things you enjoy. Variety is both physically and psychologically advantageous.

Student Summit Inspires a New Generation of Game Changers

More than 300 student leaders from the Black Gold School Division and Maskwacis Education Schools Commission gathered at Ohpaho Secondary School on April 22 for the 2025 Youth Leadership Summit—a one-day event focused on building leadership and empathy.

The summit, themed “Game Changers,” brought together students in Grades 4 through 12 for workshops, keynote presentations, and peer connections. Held on a division-wide professional development day, the summit offered space for students to grow as leaders in a supportive, energized environment.

One keynote speaker for the event was Bryan Saint-Louis, director of the Global Leadership Academy and founder of BSL Speaks. Saint-Louis has dedicated his career to empowering young individuals, developing future leaders, and effecting institutional change through the concept of “Radical Empathy.”

ALBERTA NEXT: Albertans to choose path forward

Alberta News, May 5, 2025

Alberta's government has announced its next steps in securing a prosperous path forward for Albertans.

Over the past decade, Liberal governments – backed by the NDP – have enacted policies that Albertans feel undermine their economy and future. This has led to widespread frustration following the recent federal election.

While Alberta is willing to collaborate in good faith with Prime Minister Mark Carney to reverse these policies, the province will take immediate steps to protect its interests until tangible changes are made.

"We continue to do all in our power to counteract Ottawa's chill on investment in energy, agriculture and our other job sectors. We have fought these attacks from Ottawa furiously and have won some important battles, but the lost opportunities, jobs and futures of so many Albertans are costly and demoralizing – as are the growing number of eastern politicians who choose to openly demonize and target Alberta for political gain. That is why a large majority of Albertans, myself included, are so deeply frustrated with the results of last week's federal election and it is why we must take action and are doing so imminently." Danielle Smith, Premier

First, Premier Danielle Smith will soon appoint a special negotiating team to represent our province in negotiations with the federal government with the hope that this will result in a binding agreement that Albertans can have confidence in. The following reforms will be requested:

- Guaranteed corridor and port access to tidewater off the Pacific, Arctic and Atlantic coasts for the international export of Alberta oil, gas, critical minerals and other resources in amounts supported by the free market, rather than by the dictates and whims of Ottawa.
- The end of all federal interference in the development of provincial resources by repealing the no new pipelines law Bill C-69, the oil tanker ban, the net zero electricity regulations, the oil and gas emissions cap, the net zero vehicle mandate, and any federal law or regulation that purports to regulate industrial carbon emissions, plastics or the commercial free speech of energy companies.
- The federal government must refrain from imposing export taxes or restrictions on the export of Alberta resources without the consent of the Government of Alberta.

- The federal government must provide to Alberta the same per-capita federal transfers and equalization as is received by the other three largest provinces – Quebec, Ontario and British Columbia.

Second, while these negotiations with Ottawa are ongoing, Alberta's government will appoint, and Premier Smith will chair, the Alberta Next panel. This panel will be composed of some of the province's best and brightest judicial, academic and economic minds, to hold a series of in-person and online town halls to discuss Alberta's future in Canada, and specifically, what next steps Alberta can take as a province to better protect itself from any current or future hostile policies of the federal government.

Details of the membership and scope of that panel will also be released in the coming weeks.

After the work of the panel is finished, it is likely we will place some of the more popular ideas discussed with the panel to a provincial referendum so all Albertans can vote on them sometime in 2026.
