The Breton Library and Breton Museum hosted 40 people to an author talk by Russell Cobb and his recent book,"The Ghosts of Crook County".

Russell skilfully told the story of indigenous land allotments in Oklahoma during the late 1800's and early 20th century, and how 3 different woman all claimed they were the mother of Tommy Atkins whose land allotment was in the oil rich Cushing Oilfield.

Sallie Atkins was one of the women, the mother of Neoma Hooks, who with her husband Sam Hooks settled at Keystone. Several descendants of Neoma's were on hand to listen as the author wove a most interesting tale of intrigue.






