THORSBY RCMP RECOVER MULTIPLE STOLEN VEHICLES

RCMP Alberta Media Relations, August 1, 2025

Leduc County, Alta. – On July 15, 2025, at approximately 1:38 p.m., Thorsby RCMP received a report of a suspicious male passed out in a vehicle on a rural property in Leduc County.

Thorsby RCMP attended the property and located a male inside a pickup truck attached to a flatbed trailer. The male was slumped over in the driver's seat of the vehicle. Thorsby RCMP confirmed the identity of the male and arrested him for an outstanding warrant. Further investigation resulted in Thorsby RCMP locating a loaded firearm inside the vehicle on the passenger seat.

Thorsby RCMP confirmed the trailer attached to the truck the male was occupying to be stolen. Several other vehicles located on the property and surrounding treeline were confirmed stolen and recovered by RCMP. The approximate value of all recovered items was \$427,000.

Riley Garrett (29), a resident of Edmonton, was arrested and charged with the following:

- · Careless use of a firearm;
- Possess a weapon for a dangerous purpose;
- · Occupy a motor vehicle knowing a firearm inside;
- Possess a firearm without a license;
- Possession of a loaded firearm with readily accessible ammunition;
- Possession of property obtained by crime over \$5,000 (x7);
- Fail to comply with an order (x2);
- Operate motor vehicle while prohibited.

Garrett was transported to Edmonton Remand Center awaiting his next court appearance.



30 YEARS OF PASTORAL MINISTRY HERE IN THORSBY

Pastor Glen and Linda McBride celebrated their historic anniversary with New Life Christian Fellowship on July 27th, 2025.

It was a day of tributes and memories from people who have been touched by their influence in the church and the community. Some of those paying tribute were Mayor Darryl Hostyn, Phyllis Madiuk on behalf of the Legion, David Noack spoke on behalf of the board, Lori Paul on behalf of the Womens Ministry, Stacey McBride-Pollosco brought a message from an interim student pastor- Jerrika Yakimchuk.

Their son, Tim McBride spoke of dad and mom's influence on his life and the lives of his sisters Amanda and Stacey. He recalled his Father saying, "I don't pastor a church, I pastor a community".

Mayor Darryl Hostyn commented on Pastor Glen's job being a very unique one stating that very few jobs are 24/7 like his. His presentation on behalf of Thorsby was rather "unique" as well. It was a wooden plague made by

Public Works which displayed the key to the city (so-to-speak). Apparently, due to budget restraints, it was made with screws and wires. There was a skeleton key mounted on it, he said, that could only be used at night, and that is why there were three candle holders on it, so you could see where to put the key at night. This was a great practical joke. Pastor Glen



has always been one who loves humour. He also presented a dinner certificate for the two of them to get out together.

There were special music tributes by the Sanders Family and by Kristen Neumann.

Pastor Glen and Linda had been youth pastors in Drayton Valley, and 100 Mile House. They pastored in Jasper and in Beaverlodge prior to coming to Thorsby.

The guest speaker from the head office of the Albertal and NWT District of the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada, was Rev. Bob Jones. He showed and commented on slides from over the past years. "Pastor Glen and Linda's fingerprints are all over this place". Pastor Glen was presented with a certificate to

commemorate 30 years on pastoral ministry in the same church. This is the first time in the history of the district that any pastor has ever been presented with this certificate. He is also one of the first to ever receive a Bth degree (Bachelor of Theology).

Pastor Ken Bishop closed the tributes by bringing some shocking facts. "Pastor Glen has performed 161

weddings and 137 funerals. If one person from each of these events was here today. and if they all gave a 60 second tribute, it would take five hours. This does not include the counselling and water baptisms he has done." Pastor Ken reminisced about the many years that they have know each other and how they had pastored at neighbouring towns in northern Alberta.



RESPONSE TO CHINA'S DUTIES ON CANOLA IMPORTS

Alberta News, August 12, 2025

Minister Sigurdson issued the following statement in response to new preliminary anti-dumping duties on canola imports:

"China's decision to impose a 75.8 per cent tariff on additional Canadian canola products is another devastating blow to Alberta's agriculture industry. This comes on top of the existing 100 per cent tariffs on canola oil, canola oil cake and peas and threatens to cut Alberta producers out of one of their most valuable markets almost entirely.

"China is Alberta's second-largest agricultural export market, worth \$2.4 billion in 2024, with canola, peas and pork making up \$1.7 billion of that trade. Nearly 70 per cent of Alberta's canola seed exports are destined for China, which is also the world's largest importer of canola and sources nearly all its supply from Canada. Losing this market could have serious consequences for farm families, processing facilities and rural communities across our province.

"These tariffs by China are in response to the federal government's decision to impose 100 per cent tariffs on Chinese electric vehicles and 25 per cent tariffs on steel and aluminum, effective October 2024. Alberta's farmers, ranchers and processors did not create this situation, yet they are paying the price. While we acknowledge Canada's request for World Trade Organization dispute consultations over the March 20 tariffs, more urgent and active federal intervention is needed to resolve this dispute - an issue they created.

"Alberta is once again calling on Ottawa to act swiftly, engage in constructive dialogue with China, and restore access to one of our most critical markets before more livelihoods are lost."





DECREASE IN CRIME SEVERITY INDEX ACROSS THE PROVINCE

Alberta RCMP sees 6.9% decrease in Crime Severity Index across the province

Edmonton – The Statistics Canada report on Police-reported crime statistics in Canada, 2024 shows that there was a 6.9% decrease in the Crime Severity Index (CSI) across Alberta RCMP jurisdictions compared to 2023. The crime score in Alberta RCMP jurisdictions is the second lowest it has been since 2015. The CSI tracks both volume and seriousness of police-reported crime. It assigns weights to different offences based on how severe they are; more serious crimes carry a higher weight than less serious crimes.

In Alberta there are 147 different RCMP jurisdictions that are measured for the CSI. These jurisdictions are policed by the 113 RCMP detachments across the province. Of the 147 jurisdictions policed by the RCMP 95 had a decrease in the CSI from 2023 to 2024.

Jurisdictions with small population sizes can generally see higher fluctuations in their CSI score year-to-year. This is because even small changes in crime, especially if they are violent crimes, can have a significant impact on the scores. Jurisdictions with larger populations are less likely to have large fluctuations in CSI scores; however, we have seen significant decreases in CSI scores in many of our larger jurisdictions. Wetaskiwin with a population of 13,412 saw a 19.2% decrease, Strathmore with a population of 16,189 saw a 24.6% decrease, and Red Deer with a population of 112,917, the largest jurisdiction the Alberta RCMP oversees, saw a 19.7% decrease. These statistics demonstrate a significant decrease in crime in these communities, brought on by the hard work of RCMP employees, and from the efforts of community members themselves.

In Alberta the top 10 CSI contributions account for 74.9% of the crime across the province. The number one contributor to Alberta's CSI score is Break & Enters making up 17.67% of the scoring. While Break & Enters are the highest cause of the CSI in Alberta it is down compared to 2023 with there being 875 fewer Break & Enters reported to the RCMP.

Of the top 10 contributors to the CSI in Alberta two were in violent crime categories: Assault and Sexual Assault. Both crimes have seen a decline over the past year with there being 653 fewer Assaults, and 273 fewer Sexual Assaults across the province.

Violent crimes like Assault and Sexual Assault can lead to significant trauma, not just to the individuals effected, but to their friends, their family, and the community they call home. The pain of these crimes is frequently long lasting, impacting those effected for years to come. Decreases in these heinous crimes are more than just a number, they are a significant benefit to the health and well-being of Albertan Communities.

"We are extremely pleased to see Crime Scores declining across the province," says Deputy Commissioner Trevor Daroux, Commanding Officer of the Alberta RCMP. "This trend reflects the shared efforts of Alberta RCMP officers, the communities we serve, and our dedicated partner agencies. We're sincerely grateful for the support we've received. Reducing crime isn't the work of one group, it demands collaboration among public services, community partners, and all level of government, but these results show that when we work together, we get results. There is still a long way to go, but the Alberta RCMP remains committed to working with our partners to protect Albertans and strengthen the communities we all proudly call home."

The Alberta RCMP uses the information gathered through the CSI to develop comprehensive, intelligence-led strategies that help to break the cycle of criminal activity over the long-term. They look at people, places, and crime types prevalent in Alberta's most vulnerable communities and target priority offenders who cause the most harm.

In the past year, the Alberta RCMP has taken significant steps to increase the safety and resilience of the communities it serves. We have leveraged technologies, like Remotely Piloted Aircraft Systems, to assist our frontline operations, as well as improved our Real Time Operation Centre, which triages calls for service and dispatches resources across the province. We have also deployed Community Response Teams throughout rural Alberta, providing focused outreach and targeted enforcement. Our specialized crime reduction teams also work with community partners to help address the root causes of crime and educate Albertans on how to stay safe.

The RCMP continues to look for new and innovative methods to help reduce crime across the province to keep Albertans safe.
