

## 10 Ways to Save Money on Back to School Shopping

- Understand school supply needs and wants It's
  crucial that you have a good understanding of what
  your child needs for school, versus what they want for

## REPEAT OFFENDERS ARRESTED

RCMP Alberta News, August 27, 2025

### Wetaskiwin RCMP arrest Repeat Offender in Central Alberta

Wetaskiwin, Alta. - On Aug. 20, 2025, investigators from the Wetaskiwin RCMP Crime Reduction Unit (CRU) & Ponoka General Investigation Section (GIS) where searching for a wanted priority offender.

Ponoka GIS learnt that the subject was hiding at a property in Wetaskiwin County. Wetaskiwin CRU members established surveillance on the property and observed a suspected stolen truck leaving. While conducting surveillance, the truck deliberately rammed a police vehicle in an attempt to disable it. RCMP Police Dog Services attempted to stop the truck but it fled at a high rate of speed. The truck was disabled using a tire deflation device in Leduc County near Warburg, Alta. Unfortunately, the subject managed to steal a Honda dirt bike from a rural property and continued fleeing for a short distance.

With the assistance of EPS AIR 1, EPS TRAP, RCMP Emergency Response Team, Leduc RCMP Stryke Team, Wetaskiwin GIS, RCMP Police Dog Services, RCMP Community Response Team & RTOC, Bryan Moffit was taken into custody.

The truck was examined by the RCMP Auto Theft Unit and confirmed to be stolen out of Red Deer, Alta.

As a result of this investigation, Bryan Moffitt (28), has been charged with;

- · Assault With Weapon;
- Possession of property obtained by crime over \$5000:
- Possession of property obtained by crime less than or equal \$5000;
- Fraudulent concealment;
- Alter/Destroy/Remove a Vehicle Identification Number;
- · Dangerous operation of motor vehicle;
- Breaking and entering with intent;
- Theft of motorcycle;
- Flight From Peace Officer.

Moffitt was taken before a Justice of the Peace and remanded into custody for future court dates at the Alberta Court of Justice in Ponoka.

The following day, Wetaskiwin Crime Reduction Unit members executed a search warrant at the property where the stolen truck initially left. Investigators seized a rifle, homemade shotgun, fentanyl, methamphetamine, drug packaging materials, a digital scale, a rifle, two stolen Husqvarna lawnmowers, and a partial stolen VIN plate

As a result of this investigation, Patrick McAuley (42),

has been charged with:

- Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking Fentanyl;
- Possession of a controlled substance Meth.;
- Possession of property obtained by crime less than or equal \$5000 (x2);
- Weapons possession contrary to order and fail to surrender authorization (x2);
- Possession of weapon for dangerous purpose (x2);
- Possession of a firearm when knowing possession unauthorized;
- · Breach of recognizance.

McAuley was taken before a Justice of the Peace and remanded into custody with his initial court date set for Aug. 26, 2025, at the Alberta Court of Justice in Wetaskiwin.

"These arrest highlights the effective partnership between the RCMP and the Edmonton Police Service said A/Sgt John Learn of the Wetaskiwin Crime Reduction Unit. Thanks to the quick response of EPS Air 1 and the combined efforts of all the RCMP units involved, this incident was brought to a safe conclusion."



# MEASLES ARE YOU IMMUNIZED?

Dr. Sunil Sookram, Alberta's interim Chief Medical Officer of Health, August 13, 2025

Measles remains one of the most contagious illnesses in the world, spreading through the air when an infected person breathes, coughs or sneezes. In recent months, measles has been spreading in Alberta, across Canada and around the world.

While measles can be serious for anyone, it's especially dangerous during pregnancy. Infection increases the risk of miscarriage, early labor, low birth weight, and even infant death. In rare but devastating cases, the virus passes to the unborn child, causing congenital measles—a serious condition that can lead to lifelong disability or death. Pregnant individuals also face a far greater risk of severe complications, including pneumonia and hospitalization.

So far in 2025, fewer than five babies in Alberta have been diagnosed with congenital measles—all born to mothers who were not immunized. Some required intensive care. There have also been 46 confirmed cases among pregnant individuals, with fewer than five hospitalizations. While the numbers are low, they serve as a stark reminder of what can happen when immunity gaps persist. If you are pregnant and think you may have been exposed to measles, stay home and contact your health care provider, midwife or Health Link at 811 for further guidance.

If you're planning to get pregnant or considering it, ensure you receive two doses of the vaccine at least one month before conception. Although the vaccine isn't given during pregnancy, immune mothers can pass temporary protection to their newborns — a crucial safeguard, since babies under six months are too young to be immunized. In some cases, immune globulin may be offered to exposed pregnant individuals or infants, but it provides only short-term protection. Being immunized before pregnancy provides the best protection from getting infected.

Canada eliminated measles in 1998 through strong routine immunization programs. But outbreaks can still happen. In areas where immunization coverage is low, measles can spread more easily and quietly, making it harder to control.

As children head back to school or start homeschooling, now is the time to check your immunization status as well as that of your children. Whether in classrooms, homeschool co-ops, or community programs, children are often in close contact. Even if one child is unprotected, measles can spread rapidly – putting classmates, siblings, and vulnerable individuals at risk.

The good news? Vaccination efforts across Alberta are

making a difference. Since March 16, more than 92,000 measles vaccines have been given – a 56% increase over last year. Uptake has risen by 119% in the South Zone and 92% in the North. Early doses for babies aged 6 to 11 months in high-risk areas have increased by 432%, thanks to targeted outreach.

Since mid-May, Alberta has run a provincewide immunization campaign in more than 14 languages. The message is clear: Don't get measles. Get immunized. With strong uptake continuing, the campaign is being extended and will include new messaging focused on back-to-school season and pregnancy.

While weekly case numbers have fluctuated, we're encouraged by the lack of any sustained upward trend. Expanded clinics, focused outreach, and consistent public health messaging are helping to ensure this important information reaches all Albertans and helps to slow the spread.

Still, the work isn't done. Community protection depends on immunization rates of 95 per cent or higher. Getting both doses of the vaccine is a simple but powerful way to protect our homes, schools, and communities.

If you're unsure about your immunization status or that of your children, speak with your doctor or midwife. You can also call Alberta's measles hotline at 1-844-944-3434 to check your records, ask questions and book an appointment.


