

- Bylaw compliant backyard and camping fires
- Fires contained within approved facilities and appliances in designed camping and recreational areas







## EDUCATION NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE

Alberta News, September 5, 2025

President of Treasury Board and Minister of Finance Nate Horner issued the following statement about contract negotiations with the TEBA and the ATA:

"Albertans have immense respect for the role teachers play in supporting students and building a caring education community. Alberta's government remains committed to reaching a fair deal for our teachers.

"However, in a media statement last week, Alberta Teacher Association (ATA) President Jason Schilling stated, 'talks are off until the Government shows it takes teachers' concerns more seriously.'

"Over the summer, I met with my caucus colleagues to review and approve practical and constructive proposals that would hopefully lead to a tentative agreement with our teachers.

"On August 26, Teachers' Employer Bargaining Association (TEBA) proposed a settlement that agreed to provide the hiring commitment requested by the ATA-hiring 3,000 new teachers over the course of the three school years of the agreement. TEBA's proposal additionally included a similar compensation offer that was previously recommended by the ATA to their members.

"Hiring 3,000 teachers would have cost about threequarters of a billion dollars over the three years. According to the ATA themselves, it would have helped alleviate population growth and classroom complexity pressures, especially in elementary schools, something that teachers have said is a top priority for them.

"The cost of the current proposed deal over the full term, is over \$2.3 billion, which includes substantial raises for teachers. While the general wage increase is 12 per cent over four years, just like the other negotiated deals with the nurses and public sector workers, over 95 per cent of teachers would receive more through market adjustments, depending on their region and role.

"Last week, I shared the first quarter fiscal update and economic statement and mentioned that 2025 has brought its share of challenges for everyone. We are now forecasting a \$6.5 billion deficit, our first deficit in five years. Considering our fiscal update, making room for \$750 million was not going to be easy, but we were

committed to reaching a fair deal for teachers and stability for students and families.

"The headline on a news release from the ATA says public education is at risk due to bargaining impasse. The ATA's bargaining team can solve this impasse. Refusing to bargain now is not an effective labour relations strategy and is unfair to all teachers across Alberta.

"While union leaders reconsider their tactics, TEBA remains ready to return to the table to secure a fair agreement. Our government is committed to a responsible outcome that balances the needs of teachers, families and taxpayers alike."

#### **RCMP Updates**

Sqt. Rob Gillies, Breton Detachment and Staff Sgt. Ryan Hoetmer, Drayton Valley Detachment presented their quarterly updates.

In Drayton Valley, there has been a 31.7% decrease in Criminal Code offences from January-July 2025 compared to the same period in 2024.

In Breton, total Criminal Code offences have decreased 11% from January-July 2025 compared to the same period in 2024.

Detachments continue to focus on reducing property crime, managing prolific offenders, reducing impaired driving, and community engagement.


#### Support for First Aid in High Schools



#### Village of Breton 2025 Election October 20, 2025

#### Do you want to make a difference in your community?

This fall you have the chance to do so: not only by the vote you cast for your municipal Councillors, but also by running for municipal office yourself. Here are some things you should consider before you file a nomination paper.

#### Do I qualify?

To become a candidate you must be:

- at least 18 years old on nomination date
- a Canadian citizen, and
- a resident of the municipality for the six-months preceding nomination day.

You are NOT eligible to be nominated if:

- you are an employee of the municipality, unless granted a leave of absence
- your property taxes are more than \$50 in arrears or you are in default for more than 90 days, or owe any other debt in excess of \$500 to the municipality.

(See the Local Authorities Election Act for further details.)

#### Do I have the time?

There will be demands on your time. You will be elected for a four-year term and during that time you will be required under the Municipal Government Act to attend:

- Regular Meetings of Council (once a month excluding July and August)
- Meetings of Council Committees (varies but usually a few times per year)
- ◆ Meetings of other boards and agencies to which you are appointed as Council's representative (varies from monthly to quarterly but generally one a month)
- ◆ Conferences, conventions, seminars, and workshops for training and discussion (varies from twice to three times per year)
- Social and other events promoting your municipality.

Some of these meetings are during the daytime, so it is important to ensure you can get the time off from your employment.

#### Filing your nomination

**September 22, 2025** has been declared nomination day. The completed nomination form is to be filed with the Returning Officer before 12:00 noon this day. Nomination packages can be picked up at the Village office.

## BETTER, FASTER, SMARTER ACCESS TO GOVERNMENT SERVICES

Alberta's government is launching the Alberta Wallet, giving Albertans the option to carry their Government of Alberta-issued documents on their phones.

Leading the way in Canada, the Mobile Health Card will be the first document available for Albertans to add to the Alberta Wallet. This is part of the province's health card modernization initiative and commitment to delivering better, faster and smarter services.

With security and privacy at the core, the Alberta Wallet and Mobile Health Card are protected by strong encryptions, ensuring that Albertans' personal information stays private and accessible only to them. Albertans will also be in control of their personal information as nothing is shared with third parties without their consent.

"Albertans deserve better, faster and smarter services. That's why we're launching this optional tool to supplement Albertans' existing paper health cards. If you choose to use the new Alberta Wallet, you remain in control of your personal information, which will stay private and only accessible to you." Danielle Smith, Premier

"Albertans expect modern, convenient service delivery and that includes how they obtain, store and renew important government documents. With the Alberta Wallet, we are providing a secure, user-friendly option for those who prefer it. This is the kind of innovation that puts Albertans first." Nate Glubish, Minister of Technology and Innovation

The Mobile Health Card will serve as valid proof of health insurance coverage throughout Alberta and can be presented at hospitals, clinics and other medical settings – just like the current paper card. The Mobile Health Card will offer a more secure, convenient and durable alternative to the paper document.

The Mobile Health Card will be available to eligible Albertans aged 14 and older. Parents and guardians will be able to add their children's Mobile Health Cards to their own Alberta Wallets. Spouses and interdependent partners can also add each other's Mobile Health Cards to their Alberta Wallets.

"With the Mobile Health Card, Albertans have secure, instant access to their health information anytime, anywhere. This innovation helps providers deliver care faster and more efficiently, ensuring Albertans receive

the treatment they need when they need it." Adrianna LaGrange, Minister of Primary and Preventative Health Services

The new Alberta Wallet and Mobile Health Card are optional, and while they are a smarter and faster alternative to the physical cards, Albertans who prefer paper health cards can still use them.

To access the wallet, Albertans will need a Verified Alberta.ca Account and a MyHealth Records account to add their Mobile Health Card. More documents will be added over time and Albertans will be able to access them through the mobile application or online through their Verified Alberta.ca Account.

As part of the health care card modernization initiative, Alberta will also introduce an integrated driver's licence and health care card in 2026.






