Thorsby's volunteer run Chamber is

Thorsby CIB also takes care of the Hope Garden at the Cenotaph near the Firehall.





NEW BLEACHERS

CIB & the Town of Thorsby Recreation Department will also be taking the lead in the purchase of

new bleachers for one of the ball diamonds at the Thorsby Recreation Complex. In the spring, Kelley Probe (Complex Manager), Shawna Ofstie (Thorsby & District Chamber of Commerce), Barry Rasch (CIB) & Sherri Morrissey (Thorsby Bandits) discussed a partnership to purchase the new bleachers. So far volunteers from the above groups raised \$3,146.61 at Arctic Spas 30th anniversary celebration and the Chamber of Commerce raised \$6,469.77 at their May Long weekend ball tournament for a total of \$9,616.38 raised. CIB will continue to fundraise and apply for grants for this approximately \$50,000 project.





RCMP Alberta News, September 3, 2025

Alberta RCMP issues 1661 tickets over Labour Day long weekend

Edmonton - From Aug. 29 to Sept. 1, your Alberta RCMP conducted enhanced traffic safety enforcement across the province, resulting in 1661 traffic safety infractions.

Of the 1661 tickets issued, 789 were for speeding, 34 for distracted driving, and 19 for not wearing a seatbelt.

Additionally, 99 impaired drivers were removed from the roads. 70 drivers received Immediate Roadside Sanction (IRS) FAILs and 19 received IRS WARNs.

Unfortunately, over the long weekend, there were 54 collisions which caused injuries, resulting in 4 deaths.

"Fatal motor vehicle collisions are often avoidable." says Sgt. Darrin Turnbull, Alberta RCMP Traffic, "and we are reminded of this every long weekend when lives are lost due to factors such as drugs, alcohol, and speeding."

Your Alberta RCMP is urging everyone to remember that there is no reason to get behind the wheel if you are impaired. If road conditions are unfavourable, consider delaying travel until they improve, and always give yourself extra time to get where you are going.

Traffic safety is a shared responsibility. Call 911 if you observe dangerous driving.



ALBERTA TEACHERS' **ASSOCIATION BARGAINING:** Joint Statement

Alberta News, August 28, 2025

President of Treasury Board and Minister of Finance Nate Horner and Minister of Education and Childcare Demetrios Nicolaides issued the following statement on negotiations with the ATA:

"We are deeply concerned and disappointed with the decision of the Alberta Teachers' Association (ATA) to break off negotiations with so much at stake, and so close to a reasonable settlement.

"The Teachers' Employer Bargaining Association (TEBA) met with the teachers' union and a mediator this week to continue negotiating a new central agreement.

"The ATA has been maintaining their ongoing public campaign saying that teachers, families and students want better classroom conditions.

"We heard their bargaining concerns and carefully considered how we could best support teachers, students and their classrooms.

"They have been offered what they asked for. They have been offered what they said was needed.

"On August 26, TEBA made an offer to the ATA that included hiring 1,000 more teachers every year for the next three years at an estimated total cost of \$750 million over the term; an offer that provides the exact request the union made in June of 2025.

"Three thousand more teachers would certainly have a significant impact in alleviating classroom pressures and improve the education landscape for teachers and students.

"A 12 per cent salary increase over four years was also offered, as well as an additional increase that would further improve the salaries of 95 per cent of their members over the next four years. This would result in greater salary increases for newer teachers to help address recruitment and retention issues.

"On August 27, the ATA's bargaining team rejected this offer, and suggested that a contract with fewer teachers would save money and that funding could be funnelled into even higher salaries.

"The union's strategy and tactics have been exposed and called out. We cannot sit idle while the public, parents and students are manipulated into supporting a union that has shown its primary interest is in diverting supports away from the classroom to further drive up teacher compensation."
